<p><b>Registered Nurse Obstetrics</b> Per Diem - Nights</p>	<p><b>Required Education, Licenses/Certifications, and Experience:</b> Current California R.N. license. Six months recent experience in perinatal nursing preferred. BLS and successful completion of neonatal resuscitation within six months of employment.</p> <p><b>Position Responsibilities:</b> The staff nurse in Obstetrics functions independently in performing the nursing process through assessment, planning, implementation and evaluation of safe therapeutic care for all patients during labor, deliver, immediate post-partum and newborn care; including those patients in complex situations with overt and covert needs and/or complications of treatment during his/her shift. The staff nurse manages and coordinates the clinical activities on the patient unit during his/her shift.</p>
<p><b>Registered Nurse First Assistant or Physician Assistant Surgery</b> Full-time or Part-time Benefited</p>	<p><b>Required Education, Licenses/Certifications, and Experience:</b> Current California RN License or current California Physician Assistant License. Successfully completed an approved RNFA course of instruction and met the proctoring criteria. Minimum two (2) years perioperative experience. ACLS required.</p> <p><b>Position Responsibilities:</b> The RNFA renders direct patient care as part of the perioperative team by functioning as a first assistant under the supervision of a surgeon with active privileges at Fairchild Medical Center.</p>
<p><b>Registered Nurse Emergency Department</b> Full Time/Per Diem</p>	<p><b>Required Education, Licenses/Certifications, and Experience:</b> Current California R.N. License required. BLS and ACLS certification required with six (6) months. Minimum of one (1) year acute care experience within the past two(2) years preferred.</p> <p><b>Position Responsibilities:</b> The staff nurse in the Emergency Department functions independently in performing the nursing process through assessment, planning, intervention and evaluation of safe therapeutic care for all patient's overt and covert needs and/or complications of treatment in the Emergency Department. Manages and coordinates the clinical activities in the department during his/her shift.</p>
<p><b>Registered Nurse Intensive Care Unit</b> Full Time/Per Diem</p>	<p><b>Required Education, Licenses/Certifications, and Experience:</b> Current California R.N. License. BLS and ACLS certification required within six (6) months. Minimum of one (1) year critical care experience within the last three (3) years required. Satisfactory completion of a course in critical care, intensive care or coronary care within the last three (3) years preferred.</p> <p><b>Position Responsibilities:</b> Function independently in performing the nursing process through assessment, planning, intervention and evaluation of safe therapeutic care for all patient's overt and covert needs and/or complications of treatment on his/her shift. The staff nurse manages and coordinates the clinical activities on the patient unit during his/her shift.</p>
<p><b>Registered Nurse Med/Surg</b> Full Time</p>	<p><b>Required Education, Licenses/Certifications, and Experience:</b> Current California RN License and BLS required. Minimum of one (1) year acute care experience within the past three (3) years preferred.</p> <p><b>Position Responsibilities:</b> The staff nurse in the Med/Surg Unit functions independently in performing the nursing process through assessment, planning, intervention and evaluation of safe therapeutic care for all patient's overt and covert needs and/or complications of treatment on his/her shift. The staff nurse manages and coordinates the clinical activities on their patient assignment and may be assigned to coordinate the unit activities during his/her shift.</p>
<p><b>Registered Nurse Surgery</b> Full Time</p>	<p><b>Required Education, Licenses/Certifications, and Experience:</b> Current California R.N. License required. BLS &amp; ACLS required within six (6) months. One (1) recent year Operating Room experience preferred.</p> <p><b>Position Responsibilities:</b> The staff nurse in the Operating Room functions independently in performing the nursing process through assessment, planning, intervention and evaluation of safe therapeutic care for all patient's overt and covert needs and/or complications of treatment on his/her shift. The staff nurse manages and coordinates the clinical activities on their patient assignment and may be assigned to coordinate the unit activities during his/her shift.</p>
<p><b>Medical Technologist Laboratory</b> Full Time</p>	<p><b>Required Education, Licenses/Certifications, and Experience:</b> Current California Department of Health Services Clinic Laboratory Scientist license required. One (1) to three (3) years of CLS experience preferred. Expanded knowledge and interest in one or more laboratory departments is preferred.</p> <p><b>Position Responsibilities:</b> Performs all Laboratory test necessary for the diagnosis and treatment of patients at the request of the attending physician(s). Responsible for reporting accurate results substantiated by the use of appropriate controls. Demonstrates proficiency and understanding of routine procedures for all areas of the clinical laboratory with minimal supervision.</p>
<p><b>Shift Supervisor Nursing Administration</b> Per Diem</p>	<p><b>Required Education, Licenses/Certifications, and Experience:</b> Current California RN License required. BLS, ACLS required within six (6) months. Recent Supervisory experience preferred.</p> <p><b>Position Responsibilities:</b> The shift supervisor coordinates the delivery of patient care for all nursing departments in the hospital. They are responsible for providing adequate staffing, within the budgeted FTE's to the various nursing departments. They act as a resource and provide direction to all nursing staff.</p>

<p><b>Surgery Manager</b>  <b>Surgical Services</b>  Full Time</p>	<p><b>Required Education, Licenses/Certifications, and Experience:</b> Current California R.N. license, BLS, ACLS required within six (6) months. Recent Managerial experience in healthcare required. BSN or Master's degree preferred.</p> <p><b>Position Responsibilities:</b> Responsible for assessing, planning, implementing and evaluating the overall operation of the OR/PACU/Central Supply/SPD/OP Surgery on a 24 hour basis. Implementing policy and procedure with continuous review and revisions. Possesses the ability to assess departmental flow for efficiency and timeliness, and develops budget preparation. Works well with surgeons and anesthesia providers to facilitate positive patient outcomes. Assesses the need for new equipment, interacts with vendors and devises the training of new equipment and ongoing competencies for staff.</p>
