<p>Registered Nurse Obstetrics Per Diem - Nights</p>	<p>Required Education, Licenses/Certifications, and Experience: Current California R.N. license. Six months recent experience in perinatal nursing preferred. BLS and successful completion of neonatal resuscitation within six months of employment.</p> <p>Position Responsibilities: The staff nurse in Obstetrics functions independently in performing the nursing process through assessment, planning, implementation and evaluation of safe therapeutic care for all patients during labor, deliver, immediate post-partum and newborn care; including those patients in complex situations with overt and covert needs and/or complications of treatment during his/her shift. The staff nurse manages and coordinates the clinical activities on the patient unit during his/her shift.</p>
<p>Registered Nurse First Assistant or Physician Assistant Surgery Full-time or Part-time Benefited</p>	<p>Required Education, Licenses/Certifications, and Experience: Current California RN License or current California Physician Assistant License. Successfully completed an approved RNFA course of instruction and met the proctoring criteria. Minimum two (2) years perioperative experience. ACLS required.</p> <p>Position Responsibilities: The RNFA renders direct patient care as part of the perioperative team by functioning as a first assistant under the supervision of a surgeon with active privileges at Fairchild Medical Center.</p>
<p>Registered Nurse Emergency Department Full Time/Per Diem</p>	<p>Required Education, Licenses/Certifications, and Experience: Current California R.N. License required. BLS and ACLS certification required with six (6) months. Minimum of one (1) year acute care experience within the past two(2) years preferred.</p> <p>Position Responsibilities: The staff nurse in the Emergency Department functions independently in performing the nursing process through assessment, planning, intervention and evaluation of safe therapeutic care for all patient's overt and covert needs and/or complications of treatment in the Emergency Department. Manages and coordinates the clinical activities in the department during his/her shift.</p>
<p>Registered Nurse Intensive Care Unit Full Time/Per Diem</p>	<p>Required Education, Licenses/Certifications, and Experience: Current California R.N. License. BLS and ACLS certification required within six (6) months. Minimum of one (1) year critical care experience within the last three (3) years required. Satisfactory completion of a course in critical care, intensive care or coronary care within the last three (3) years preferred.</p> <p>Position Responsibilities: Function independently in performing the nursing process through assessment, planning, intervention and evaluation of safe therapeutic care for all patient's overt and covert needs and/or complications of treatment on his/her shift. The staff nurse manages and coordinates the clinical activities on the patient unit during his/her shift.</p>
<p>Registered Nurse Med/Surg Full Time</p>	<p>Required Education, Licenses/Certifications, and Experience: Current California RN License and BLS required. Minimum of one (1) year acute care experience within the past three (3) years preferred.</p> <p>Position Responsibilities: The staff nurse in the Med/Surg Unit functions independently in performing the nursing process through assessment, planning, intervention and evaluation of safe therapeutic care for all patient's overt and covert needs and/or complications of treatment on his/her shift. The staff nurse manages and coordinates the clinical activities on their patient assignment and may be assigned to coordinate the unit activities during his/her shift.</p>
<p>Registered Nurse Surgery Full Time</p>	<p>Required Education, Licenses/Certifications, and Experience: Current California R.N. License required. BLS & ACLS required within six (6) months. One (1) recent year Operating Room experience preferred.</p> <p>Position Responsibilities: The staff nurse in the Operating Room functions independently in performing the nursing process through assessment, planning, intervention and evaluation of safe therapeutic care for all patient's overt and covert needs and/or complications of treatment on his/her shift. The staff nurse manages and coordinates the clinical activities on their patient assignment and may be assigned to coordinate the unit activities during his/her shift.</p>
<p>Shift Supervisor Nursing Administration Per Diem</p>	<p>Required Education, Licenses/Certifications, and Experience: Current California RN License required. BLS, ACLS required within six (6) months. Recent Supervisory experience preferred.</p> <p>Position Responsibilities: The shift supervisor coordinates the delivery of patient care for all nursing departments in the hospital. They are responsible for providing adequate staffing, within the budgeted FTE's to the various nursing departments. They act as a resource and provide direction to all nursing staff.</p>
<p>Registration Clerk/Aide Emergency Department Full Time</p>	<p>Required Education, Licenses/Certifications, and Experience: High School diploma/GED equivalent required. BLS required within six (6) months of employment. Knowledge of Medical Terminology preferred.</p> <p>Position Responsibilities: The Emergency Department Clerk/Aide will perform various clerical duties and non-professional services necessary in caring for the personal needs and comfort of the patients. Ability to write legibly, spell correctly and perform basic mathematics required. Computer/typing skills, interpersonal and communication skills required. Physical ability to assist with the care of the patients required.</p>

<p>Surgery Manager Surgery Full Time</p>	<p>Required Education, Licenses/Certifications, and Experience: Current California R.N. license, BLS, ACLS required within six (6) months. Recent Managerial experience in healthcare required. BSN or Masters degree preferred.</p> <p>Position Responsibilities: Responsible for assessing, planning, implementing and evaluating the overall operation of the OR/PACU/Central Supply/SPD/OP Surgery on a 24 hour basis. Implementing policy and procedure with continuous review and revisions. Possesses the ability to assess departmental flow for efficiency and timeliness, and develops budget preparation. Works well with surgeons and anesthesia providers to facilitate positive patient outcomes. Assesses the need for new equipment, interacts with vendors and devises the training of new equipment and ongoing competencies.</p>
<p>Medical Records I FMC Clinic Part Time, Non-Benefited</p>	<p>Required Education, Licenses/Certifications, and Experience: High School diploma, or GED equivalent required. Medical office, hospital, or other health care setting filing experience preferred. Basic office skills required.</p> <p>Position Responsibilities: Performs specific tasks associated with the filing of medical records, as well as loose medical reports and any other related departmental filing.</p>
<p>Licensed Vocational Nurse FMC Clinic Full Time/Per Diem</p>	<p>Required Education, Licenses/Certifications, and Experience: Current California LVN license required. Two (2) years of nursing in a Doctor's office preferred.</p> <p>Position Responsibilities: Administers nursing care to designated patients under the supervision of a Family Nurse Practitioner, Physician Assistant, or Physician. Performs a variety of direct and indirect patient care duties/activities.</p>
<p>Family Nurse Practitioner FMC Clinic Full Time</p>	<p>Required Education, Licenses/Certifications, and Experience: Current Family Nurse Practitioner license required. Minimum one (1) year experience required.</p> <p>Position Responsibilities: In collaboration with the physician, perform assessments and diagnosis, initiate treatment and/or therapy. Take patient history and perform physical examinations.</p>
<p>Phlebotomist Laboratory Per Diem</p>	<p>Required Education, Licenses/Certifications, and Experience: Current American Society of Phlebotomy Technicians certificate required.</p> <p>Position Responsibilities: Performs venipunctures to collect blood specimens. Performs laboratory tests in compliance with the law. Performs daily recordings of temperatures and Blood Bank inventory. Performs other duties as requested by the chief technologist.</p>
<p>Registered Physical Therapist Rehabilitation Services Full Time</p>	<p>Required Education, Licenses/Certifications, and Experience: Current California Physical Therapist License required. BLS required.</p> <p>Position Responsibilities: Responsible for organizing, conducting and developing a medically prescribed program of physical therapy in both hospital and out-patient setting.</p>
