

Deer Resistant Plants

Appearances to the contrary, deer can be discriminating diners. Some plants are particular favorites; others are more or less left alone. If you live in deer country, it's far simpler to fill the garden with less-favored plants than to protect the more choice morsels. But a word of warning: although deer generally ignore the plants listed below, their preferences vary in different areas, from year to year, and even from season to season.
