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Contact Lens Policies

What is a contact lens fitting?

A contact lens fitting is an additional, separate portion of a comprehensive eye examination. As contact lenses are most often an elective addition to a glasses prescription, many insurance companies do not cover this procedure. Any contact lens fitting fees that are not covered by insurance will be the responsibility of the patient. At L'Optique of Dallas, our contact lens fitting fees depend on the type of contact lens and do not include the actual supply of contacts. Contact lens prescriptions expire after 1 year.

What is included in a contact lens fitting?

- Determination of candidacy for contact lens wear
- Determination of contact lens prescription based on glasses prescription
- Evaluation of tear film and cornea
- Evaluation of contacts on the eye for best acuity and physiology
- Topographical analysis of cornea when necessary (additional fee)
- Insertion/removal training for first time wearers
- Contact lens trial to determine the final prescription
- Travel size contact lens solution and case
- Any contact lens related follow-ups for a period of 60 days. Any contact lens follow-up after 60 days will incur an office visit charge.
