Sacramental Prep for First Reconciliation and First Eucharist	2 nd Grade or older	\$40 per child before 8/18**	Child should be in Family Faith Formation the year prior to Sacramental Prep year (in most cases this is 1 st grade)
Confirmation Prep	11 th Grade (age 16+)	\$75 per teen before 8/18**	Teen should be in Youth Ministry the year prior to Confirmation Prep year (in most cases this is 10 th grade)
Fraternus/Fidelis Youth Groups	5 th Grade through High School	Cost TBD later	More details to come later
Children's Liturgy of the Word (CLOW)	All ages of children, but most appropriate for primary school ages	No cost	10:30 AM Mass only - Children are dismissed after the Gloria and return at Presentation of the Gifts (starts after Labor Day)
