Sunday School News for the Fall

Since last fall, the Children's Ed team has been searching for a new curriculum because the publisher had discontinued our current curriculum. Over the last few months, we have been researching curricula and have landed on a VBS model that will depart greatly from our current craft based curriculum.

A significant portion of our decision is based on how the new curriculum will affect our children and their spiritual development. We believe that they will gain a deeper understanding of scripture through a variety of differentiated activities. The premise of this new curriculum is to teach all students, ages 4 through 5th grade, the same themes at their respective learning levels. Each unit is comprised of four learning areas that include art, music, science, movies, games, cooking and others.

Our hope is to include a broader pool of volunteers comprised of those who enjoy one on one interactions with students as well for members of the church who enjoy focused, experience based learning to impart on the students. The goal of our new curriculum is to "set the table" so that the youth of Grace can grow in their discipleship and love as participating members of our congregation.

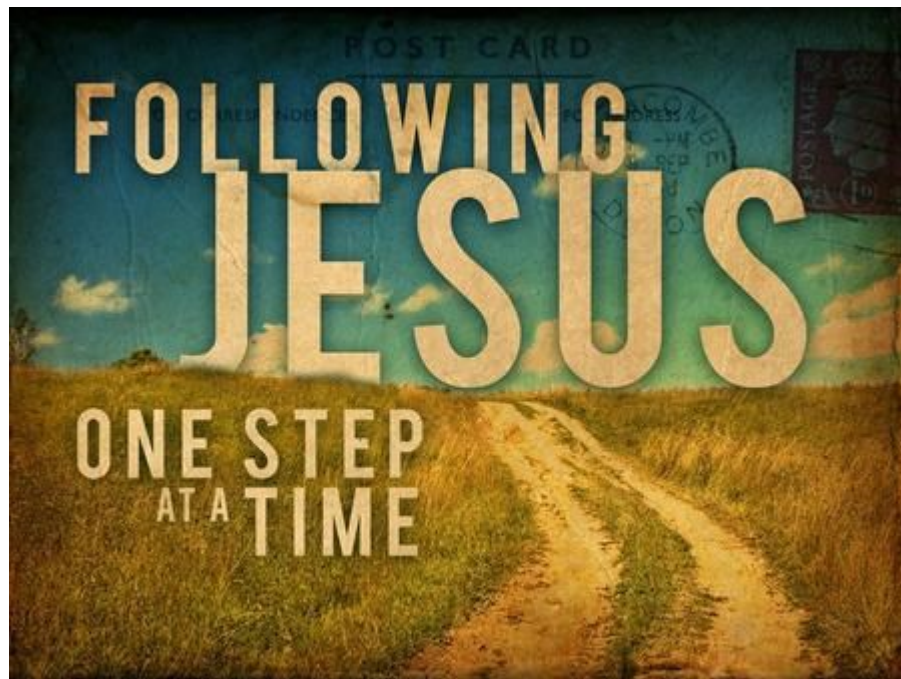
