Through a generous gift to the council endowment fund, the Nathan and Irene Dale Opportunity Fund was created to assist Scouts and Scouting units to overcome financial barriers above and beyond the capacity of the council's current campership fund. The committee meets regularly to review applications for special support. This includes areas such as camping, joining assistance, new unit startup, unit equipment, special events like National Scout Jamboree and council activities like Fall Rendezvous.

Camping scholarships, uniforms, and training costs will be considered for individual Scouts and Scouters and should be applied for with the individual application. Equipment and unit assistance requests will be considered through Unit Applications only.

The Nathan and Irene Dale Fund committee's intent is to consider all requests for funds based on their merit whether it be a unit or individual. Where applicable, the Scout law "thrifty" will be applied when considering requests for funds. The intent of the fund is to be a hand up rather than a hand out.
