INSURANCE INFORMATION:

If you wish to use medical insurance, important information regarding your mental health benefits are available directly from your insurance provider. When completing the initial intake over the phone, insurance information is gathered for billing purposes only, i.e., no insurance benefits can be quoted for you. You will need to contact your insurance company directly prior to your first visit to determine your financial responsibility. Confirmation of benefits is your responsibility and if AFC is unfamiliar with the benefit plan, you will pay full fee and credit will be applied once benefits are confirmed. When contacting your insurance provider regarding coverage, here are some questions to ask to determine your benefit level:

- Am I in-network, out-of-network, or neither?
- What are my in-network or out-of-network benefits?
- What are the Outpatient Mental Health Benefits for my policy?
- What is my co-pay percentage?
- What is my deductible?
- How many visits do I have per calendar year or policy year?
- What is the effective date of my coverage?

As courtesy to our clients, our billing department will file claims to your primary insurance provider. We do not file secondary insurance.

Here is an estimation of in or out-of-network status regarding insurance coverage for services at Amigo Family Counseling:

In Network:

- Ohio State University (NGS American)
- Ohio Health
- Medicare (for services rendered by Dr. Amigo and Michael Bayda only)

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Out of Network:

Amigo Family Counseling, LLC and its providers are not contracted with other insurance companies other than those listed above. If you have medical insurance from a different company than what is listed, find out if you have out-of-network benefits. If yes, you may choose to submit a claim to your insurance for possible reimbursement based on your policy's out-of-network benefits. Please ask for a receipt of payment at the time of services to submit for your claim to your insurance company. The following insurance companies are out-of-network with Amigo Family Counseling, LLC (this is not a comprehensive list):

- United Healthcare (United Behavioral Health)
- Cigna Health
- Anthem Blue Cross / Blue Shield (PPO Programs)
- Aetna
- Medical Mutual

Not Covered:

If your insurance company is listed above, you (or your child) may still be a client at AFC, but you will have to pay the full amount for services out of pocket. Please note that Amigo Family Counseling, LLC is not a Medicaid provider (this includes CareSource).
