Candidate Filing Information August 7, 2018 Primary Election

When and Where to File:

File Opens: February 27, 2018, 8:00 a.m.

Filing Closes: March 27, 2018, 5:00 p.m.

Location: Platte County Board of Election Commissioners
2600 NW Prairie View Rd
Platte City MO 64079

Ballot Placement:

First day filers will select a number by random draw to determine placement on the primary ballot.

After the first day, candidates will be placed on the ballot based on the date and time of filing.

Documents Required for Filing:

1. Paid receipt from County Central Committee for filing fee, or cash/check made out to the party Central Committee in the amount of \$50.00. (NOTE: Candidates for Sub-district Committeemen and Committeewomen are not required to pay a filing fee.)
2. Proof of identity- Driver's License, Birth Certificate, or other acceptable form of certified or photo identification.
3. A copy of Form 5120 – Candidate's Affidavit of Tax Payments and Bonding Requirements. The form must be notarized or we will not be able to complete the filing process. Forms are available online at: <http://dor.mo.gov/forms/5120.pdf>
4. NOTE: Candidates for **County Collector of Revenue SHALL** also provide the Election Authority a copy of the signed affidavit from a surety company authorized to do business in Missouri, indicating that the candidate meets the bond requirements for the office of County Collector.

Must File in Person (Exceptions):

Candidates for County Offices and Sub-District Committeemen and Committeewomen must file in person with the Platte County Board of Election Commissioners except for members of the armed services on active duty and disabled persons who may file by certified mail. Persons eligible to file by certified mail should contact the Election Board for further details.
