

Weybridge Selectboard Meeting

September 5, 2017

Present: Don Mason, Megan Sutton, Alix O'Meara, Bruce Paquin, Dan James, Matt Broughton, Brenda Jaring.

1. Meeting called to order by Don Mason, Chair at 7:03 PM.
2. Comments & Questions – Chickens were trapped on Pulp Mill Bridge Road after complaint from a resident. Town Hall is not in ADA compliance. Work to be done, permit needed from Natural Resources. Megan will submit a Grant to see if we can sure up any funds.
3. Gale Hurd – ACTR report, on July 1st 2017 ACTR merged with Stage Coach promoted by V-Tran a larger District. State funding may be easier to obtain now. Their new name will be Tri-Valley Transit. A Hugh Thank You for the Road Crew for their help for the Festival on the Green. There seems to be a slump on Horse Farm Road, which Matt will address when they come to do the paving in Town. Once it is paved over it will be easier to keep track of any movement. Gale would like to have her Limb Walkers that trim her trees to trim back some brush on Weybridge Road as you come out of Middlebury. She has noted she will take care of the expense. While bridges are under construction in Middlebury rider pickups will be by Twilight Hall. Some of the people that can use the services of the buses are Medicaid Recipients, Over 60; Dial a Ride and the Disabled. These are programs that can be reimbursed. Have a Community Jamboree coming up celebrating ACTR's 25th Anniversary. September 16th at the Mary Hogan Rec Field. Gale is a representative for the Regional Operating Committee.
4. Approve Minutes of August 1st – Bruce makes a motion to accept as amended, line 3 wording. Megan Second. Unanimous.
5. Highway Business – Cargill Salt Contract discussion. Getting product from Bridport to mix our own. Salt Budget over by one load last year. Matt will sign contract. Mowing & Trimming. Washing the bridges. Rattling Bridge will cost each Town 10% of the repairs (Weybridge & New Haven) and will be closed 3 weeks in October. Grading on Snake Mountain Road, complaints about dust. Possible to spot grade. Have lost signs again from theft, signs needed on order. Complaints on water puddles by Covered Bridge, going to try trenches on each side behind guard rails. Pressure washed Town Office, looks 100% better. Product needed on James Road sides a little narrow in a couple spots. Matt will be on Vacation the week of October 20th to 29th. Line Stripping Company is on schedule. State Aid roads are done.
6. Pulp Mill Bridge – Gary Perkins has been contracted to do the lights in the Pulp Mill Bridge. Rebate will be completed once lights are bought and installed.
7. Act on Bills – Bruce makes a motion to accept as reviewed and amended. Dan Second. Unanimous.

8. Office Update – Zoning Regs & Sub-Division Regs need to be on Town web site. A lot of requests for this. Tax Bills are out and money coming in. Fire Dept has asked for their appropriation earlier than usual. Ok to pay. Discussion on the Trail Balance a couple more Accounts need clarification. Bill Hinman submitted 3 errors and omissions. Discussion on them, Dan makes motion to approve. Alix Second. Unanimous.
9. Other Business – Megan opens discussion on Town Hall Grants, she will write one up. Grants can be up to \$20,000.00. After meeting with Josh Maxham, Vt. Division of Fire Safety, it was brought to attention the need for the Ramp to be corrected, Rot in the base boards, Front Steps deteriorating, Sprinklers are needed if you have more than 99 people in the building. Estimates & Permit will be needed.
10. Adjourn – Bruce makes a motion to adjourn. Dan Second. Unanimous at 8:32 PM.
