



Join the ***FiberShots 4th Annual Community Challenge and Sale***, an important fundraiser for **San Jose Museum of Quilts & Textiles**. Use your preferred fiber art medium to translate your inspiration into a 10" x 10" piece. Your donated work will be sold for \$125, with all proceeds dedicated to funding fiber art programs. Now is your chance to support an organization that advocates for fiber art and artists!

The exhibition and sale is on view July 22nd- September 3rd, 2017 in FiberSpace, a community gallery at San Jose Museum of Quilts & Textiles. The exhibition culminates in a Champagne Gala on the night of Saturday, July 22, 2017 from 6-9pm.

Your contribution of artwork to FiberShots is an important investment in the Museum's future and promotes fiber art collection and appreciation. All traditional and contemporary fiber mediums are encouraged.

FiberShots must be received by July 1, 2017.

Requirements:

- Any fiber-based material may be used. You may include other materials as long as fiber plays a prominent role.
- Work **MUST BE 10" x 10"** and not more than 3" off of the wall.
- Please include your name and title on the back **ONLY**.
- All pieces must be ready to hang with a sleeve or appropriate hardware.
- You may submit as many pieces as you like.
- All donations will be accepted. (The Museum reserves the right to exclude works that do not meet the requirements.)
- Any piece not sold during the exhibition period will be offered for sale in the Museum store.

Artwork may be shipped or hand delivered during regular museum hours.
