



POSITION TITLE: Environmental Service Worker

DESCRIPTION:

Brigadoon Village is a year round camp for children and youth with chronic illness. We are seeking a highly motivated, creative and knowledgeable person to assist our Facility Manager in daily cleaning and operations. As a member of the Brigadoon Team, you would be responsible for daily cleaning, waste management and operations.

DUTIES:

Reporting to the Facility Manager, you will be responsible for (but not limited to):

- Cleaning of floors, bathrooms, windows etc. in the cabins, dining hall and program areas.
- Restocking of inventory
- Work with volunteers and students
- Take part in facility wide training
- Help maintain and properly store equipment and supplies
- Maintain the order of Brigadoon's infection control policies and procedure
- Performs other related duties
- Sort and manage recycling and waste.
- Set up for camps and clean up after camps
- Sort, put away laundry and make beds
- Ensure the safety and wellbeing of each camper/participant
- Maintains and demonstrates knowledge of Brigadoon's emergency plan
- Works in accordance with Brigadoon's Environmental Policy and Sustainability Manual
- Works in accordance with Occupation Health and safety policies
