2014 Pinot Noir  
Santa Barbara County

100% Pinot Noir, Los Alamos Vineyard  
33% Clone 777, shallow soil with less fertility  
67% Pommard Clone, gentle slope, older vines  
Vertical Shoot Positioned Canopy  
100% Destemmed, pressed at dryness

13.2% Alcohol, 0.53 TA, 3.60 pH, .06 RS  
3,994 cases produced

This Los Alamos Vineyard wine is the first Pinot Noir from our new commitment to the Santa Barbara region. Through site selection and non-interventionist winemaking, the interplay between the broad flavors of the Pommard block and the edgy components of the 777 block bring a style that expresses both the traditional and modern of Santa Barbara Pinot Noir.
