The annual week of Pepperdine Bible Lectures approaches May 1. With keynote speakers each day and a dozen breakout sessions to choose from several times a day, it makes for a wealth of knowledge and biblical education all in one event as Christians join together in Malibu. The resurrection of Jesus is a BIG DEAL. The empty tomb is a central and indispensable point in the New Testament. The cross without the empty tomb would have been the end of the story. But since Jesus rose from the grave, our hope of eternal salvation is restored (see 1 Corinthians 15). With this in mind, we want to make a BIG DEAL out of Easter Sunday — the worldwide observance and celebration of Jesus' resurrection.

Here's how...

Sunday Sermon Series: Last Week — In the Sundays leading up to Easter, we're going to look, day by day, at the last week of Jesus' life in order to help us understand and appreciate his path from the gates of Jerusalem, to the cross, to the grave, to the right hand of God the Father.



Easter Sunday Celebration — We'll gather for worship, as we do each Sunday, to celebrate the resurrection. We'll also have our traditional **Easter Egg Hunt** for kids immediately following our worship service.

Resurrection Party! — We invite the church to return to the Family Life Center on Easter Sunday night for a delicious dinner, desserts and family activities, and the **Tri-Valley Talent Show**. Let's share talents and encourage others to reflect the joy of being new creations in Christ. So grab a friend or two, put an act together, and let Jacob know if you'd like to be part of the show!

Current Lesson: The God Who Leads


Key Passage: Galatians 2:20


