Tribal Chairman's Report

Dear Fellow Tribal Members

Well its seems a lot happens between news letters and sometimes its hard for me to keep up with everything but let me try.

As you all may know, from the announcement at the May 7, 2016 General Council meeting, the Tribal Council accepted the 21 page Decision of the Membership Committee, who after 4 months of investigation, analysis and hearing, decided to recommend the removal of descendants of Ida Louella Henthorn/Pata from the Paskenta Tribal Roll. The Committee worked very hard to give the descendant family members due process and consider every possible argument carefully and considerately. In the end though, there was no evidence offered that would support their remaining on the Paskenta Tribal Roll based on the specific criteria defined in our Tribal Constitution. Please understand, our Membership Committee and our Tribal Council do not take lightly the responsibility for maintenance of our Tribal Roll. This action was another difficult one in the long process of correcting wrongs from previous governing officials.

It is important to mention the election process for this coming election and be sure you all are aware of some important dates and requirements. First, on **June 10, 2016, nominations open**. That means any eligible voter can nominate himself or herself or someone else until **August 10, 2016 when nominations close**. Anyone nominating must complete a **Nomination Form** available from the Tribal Office. *Also, any nominated person must complete a **Nomination Certification Form** to have a thorough background check before their name can be placed on a ballot.*

The Election Board has been seated and Jason Simmons was elected Chairman and Tracy Stevens was elected the Board Secretary. The other members of the Board are Joey Luevano-Rodriguez, Kim Freeman and Luis Delara. The Election Board will be sending updates and information to you over the next several months regarding the election and election events. We very much appreciate the willingness of these individuals to serve as the Election Board.

Finally, regarding another important change, Ken Harris, the longtime and only CEO of our Tewa family of companies has announced his retirement effective July 1, 2016. Ken has been the primary leadership of Tewa in all its developmental years and leaves a lasting legacy of outstanding personnel and companies. Ken has agreed to support the Tewa Board in the transition process for a new CEO through the end of the year. We all wish to thank Ken for his many years of service to the company and the Tribe and wish him well in this next chapter of his life. Thank you Ken!



Some important dates for you to remember are:

Anyone seeking nomination or nominating someone must complete a Candidate Nomination Form, which are available on June 10th by contacting the Tribal Office via e-mail, fax or by phone.

All nominated individuals are required to complete a Candidate Certification Form also available at the Tribal Office. This form initiates the required background check. Only Certified Candidates will appear on the Tribal Election Ballot.


