Tribal Chairman's Report

Dear Fellow Tribal Members,

Summer is upon us and we are busy as ever. As you may know, Tribal Council nominations for Treasurer and Tribal Chairman opened on June 10, 2016 and will close on August 10, 2016. As nominations are made the Election Board will post the names of candidates at the Tribal Office and try to keep the information current as we move toward the election.

Because our constitution at Article IV Section 2, requires the Tribal Chairman, Tribal Vice Chairman and Treasurer cannot have felony convictions each candidate for this election must have a thorough background check before being added to the ballot. The Election Board has worked hard to make sure all candidates and others are aware of the important deadlines so every interested and eligible candidate can be on the ballot when nominations close. Someone from the Election Board will contact you.

Tribal Council members, Ambrosia Rico, Natasha Magana, Dru Alejandre and COO Damon Safranek along with Rob Gips, our attorney from DrummonWoodsum, traveled to Washington DC to meet with the Department of Interior, Bureau of Indian Affairs officials and the leadership of the National Indian Gaming Commission. The purpose of this trip was provide them information on the changes in our Tribal government over the past 2 years and to update them on the Tribe's progress since the removal of the previous Council and to provide an update on the Tribe's litigation. The meetings went very well and they expressed their full support as we move forward.

Here at home, things are moving very quickly. Our Tribal Clinics are busting at the seams and we are working hard to try and keep up. Our staff is working on expansion plans for both the Corning and Red Bluff sites. We will keep you updated as we move forward.

On the home front we are analyzing every opportunity for the resort property to ensure we are maximizing all our resources and capturing as much of the market share as possible. We will continue to update you as specific plans develop.


