ELECTION 2016 NEWS

Dear Fellow Tribal Members,

As we get closer to our Tribal election on September 10, 2016, I wanted to keep you updated on what is happening and of the important deadlines prior to the actual election on September 10, 2016..

We are contracting with True Ballot once again to help us host a fair and impartial election. They did an such excellent job on our last election we wanted to make this one a success as well. True Ballot will send all ballots to adult members and completed ballots with have to be returned to True Ballot by close of business on election day. Individuals may also choose to come to the Tribal office on voting day to cast their ballot if they choose.

The Election Board is working on the format for the candidate forums to help make them as informative and interesting as possible. The forums are scheduled for August 13th at 10am, and August 24th at 5pm. Please try to attend one or both if you want to hear directly from the candidates. You may submit questions for the candidates via e-mail to electionboard@paskenta.org

On August 10, 2016, the nomination process officially closes. If there are no more candidates filing by then we will send the information to have the ballots created and then they will be mailed to every tribal adult. Mail in ballots will have to be returned to True Ballot by the end of business on September 10, 2016 to be counted.
