Wednesdays at 10.40am in the Old Vicarage: 'Explorations'

Wednesdays at 7.30pm in the Old Vicarage:
'Meeting Jesus in the Gospel of John'

Starting on 21 February, members of the Ministry Team will lead five weekly sessions based on material provided by The Society of St John the Evangelist.

'Meeting Jesus in the Gospel of John' invites participants on a journey into deeper relationship with God by praying with the words of John the Evangelist (The Gospel According to John and First Letter of John). These two texts describe how God, out of deep love, sends God's only Son Jesus into the world, to take on human form and live among us. By learning from Jesus, his human friendships, and his teachings about the God he calls 'Father,' we will discover God as One who longs for deep intimacy with each of us. We will find that God is not a judge, a disapproving parent, a policeman, or a taskmaster; rather God is our companion, our friend, our confidant, our beloved.

Each session will end with the brief service of Compline – a traditional 'Office' for prayer at the end of the day – concluding by 8.45pm.
