



# WILDROOT ORGANIC TREE TREATMENT

- (1) Carefully expose and clean the root flare of the tree.
- (2) Following the drip line of the tree, drill holes 1 inch in diameter, six to twelve inches deep, spaced three to five feet apart.
- (3) Apply a granular organic fertilizer to the drip line of the tree at a rate of two pounds per diameter inch of the tree trunk.
- (4) Mix a quarter ounce of Wildroot Organic Concentrate in five gallons of water. You can add molasses and kelp at this time.
- (5) Pour the mixture into the holes you have drilled.
- (6) Pack the holes lightly with hardwood mulch or compost.
- (7) Repeat steps (4) and (5) to complete the tree treatment process.

This procedure will treat a 6"-7" caliper tree. It dramatically promotes drought tolerance, disease resistance, and increases nutrient uptake.
