Program Descriptions

Futsal- Futsal is a fast paced, modified indoor soccer game.

Drama- Students will read, discuss, and dramatize scenes from the book Wonder, a book about a 5th grade boy with a severe facial deformity who attends school for the first time.

Peer Mentoring- Middle school students will mentor K-2nd graders to help improve positive social interactions through game play.

Recorder- Students will be offered the support needed to master the music theory and performance skills of playing a wind instrument.

Seasonal Arts & Crafts- Students will participate in crafts related to the season.

Yearbook- Students will engage in activities that will develop skills in organization, gathering data, taking pictures and understanding layouts for the school Yearbook.

Art Club- Students will work with small groups and individually to progress their art making abilities, knowledge and skills.

Photography- Learn how to take pictures and capture the moments the way you want to remember them! Photography is art, science, engineering, and as you already know, a lot of fun!

Legos- We will explore engineering and architecture to develop problem-solving, critical-thinking, and spatial awareness skills through lego building.

Robotics- Students will be introduced to the fundamentals of the engineering design process while creating and programming a team robot.
