What is the participation policy for students?

When are practices?

- Practices will be facilitated by coaches during the week before or after school at the elementary school, based on facility availability.

Will transportation be provided?

- Family involvement is strongly encouraged, especially when it comes to transporting students to and from contests. The Saturday games will take place at the neighborhood Conference High School, CPS stadium or nearby park facility.
- Parents are responsible for arranging transportation home from after school practices for their child.
- If a school bus is needed, each school is responsible for providing adult supervision on the bus, cost, and arrangements with the bus company.

When do games take place?

- Games will be played Saturdays throughout the season. Game schedules will be published and communicated prior to season start and can be viewed on the league website at www.cps.edu/score
- Participants and spectators are welcome to stay to watch other games with adult supervision .
