## 2018 Ministry

- ★ **A new outreach for elementary schoolers.** Our first-ever Elementary School Lock-In will be full of exciting games and activities for kids in grades 2 through 5. - ★ **Outreach to Young Adults.** This FREE program is open to all college students and will include whitewater rafting, kayaking, and fun-ayking...all while sharing faith journeys and learning skills. Join us for fun and fellowship March 10-17. Registration ends March 1. (Page 3)
- ★ **Summer Camp Schedule is here.** Resident camp remains the core of the Krislund ministry. This year's listing includes many specialty camps as well as the fun-filled base camp. Now's the time to register and secure your spot. (Page 5)
- ★ **Day Camps for youth who live within easy driving distance.** Day campers have become an integral part of the summer program with the Krislund bus or van picking up camper (K-8th grade) at centralized locations about 30 minutes from the camp. Now is the time to get a spot on the bus as this option has become very popular. (Page 5)
- ★ **Mission Outreach Program of Central PA.** This ministry to persons in need in Central Pennsylvania engages people of all ages and groups of 8 or more as they come to Krislund to share their faith and give witness through service to others. - ★ **Traveling Day Camps.** This aspect of Krislund's ministry brings together the camp with church congregation partners to hold day camps as part of the church's ministry. Each camper learns the same songs and Bible stories that are shared at Krislund and enjoy friendly competitions that culminate in a Thursday overnight at Krislund. - ★ **Community Day Camps.** This outreach ministry began last year with the first camps being in Tyrone and Philipsburg. Working with the ministeriums, the school and the local governing body, Krislund will hold three day camps in Tyrone and plans are in process for Bellefonte and Galeton and other communities. Camp will be held in a local park and strive to reach those who would otherwise not hear the message of Christ. (Page 4)
- ★ **Retreats, Day Sessions, Gatherings.** With the exception of a couple of weeks over the Christmas holidays, Krislund is continually preparing for visitors - from college groups, church groups, presbytery meetings, weddings, picnics, and a host of gatherings for various reasons. ### Day Camp at Krislund for campers in grades K-8.

Day Campers spend their days in a variety of activities, including swimming, hiking, arts & crafts, field games, Adventure Park activities, and more. There is never a dull moment at Day Camp!

Day Camp runs from 8:30 a.m. – 4:30 p.m., Monday through Friday, and transportation options will be available.

Campers can sign up for one week or multiple weeks!

The cost for Day Camp is \$170 per week, which includes transportation, lunch, and activities. A bus or van will have pick-up locations in community locations. If you are providing your own transportation, the cost is \$120 per week.

#### Day Camp Add-Ons

In addition to the regular camp activities, for additional costs, campers may also participate in a variety of add-on programs such as swimming lessons, laser tag, Bellyak, and the Thursday night sleepover.
