### CIRENCESTER MARKETS TERMS & CONDITIONS

1. Stalls will be allocated by the Market Manager only.
2. All vehicles used by stallholders in connection with their sales must be removed from the Market Place as follows: by 9.00 a.m. on each Charter Market day and by 8.30am on each Farmers' Market day.  
  
and such vehicles may not return before the end of the Market day (3.00 p.m. Charter Market & 1.30 Farmers' Market) except for the purpose of replenishment of goods in which circumstances a maximum stay of 15 minutes shall be permitted. All goods and vehicles belonging to or used by stallholders must be removed from the Market Place by 6.00 p.m. on each Charter Market day and 2.30pm on each Farmers' Market day.
3. Bad language or aggressive behaviour by traders will not be tolerated at any time.
4. Stalls are not to be sub-let by traders under any circumstances.
5. Trading lines cannot be changed without the Cirencester Market Manager's consent.
6. It is the trader's responsibility to secure your overhead sheet covers and rear sheets – remember, main road directly behind stalls. Anchor weights must not be placed in the carriageway. Stalls are to be 'canopied' all year round. Canopies are to be Green and white striped and are provide by Cirencester Town Council.
7. Display of goods outside your official area, which is 8ft by 4ft, will not be allowed - the extension bar is only for your protection, not displaying of goods.
8. All traders are responsible for keeping their stall and the immediate area thereof free from rubbish. All traders are to take any rubbish away with them when they leave the Market Place. No rubbish should be allowed to collect during the working day or remain after the working day. All waste water should safely and appropriately disposed of.
9. No music is allowed and no stallholders shall call attention to his goods or use any machinery or apparatus in such a manner as to cause nuisance or annoyance to the public or other stallholders. Also, any form of pitching is against the rules.
10. No live animals or birds may be sold at Cirencester Markets without the written permission of the Council.
11. The statutory provisions for Food and Hygiene and also Trading Standards must be observed at all times.
12. Method of payment is either daily or monthly in advance. Those who pay monthly in advance will be given a 5% discount on their rent. Once a trader has traded for more than 6 consecutive weeks, they will automatically become a permanent trader back rent is payable on missed weeks (charged at 50% of the daily rent). Failure to attend the market without appropriate notice will be liable to a 100% stall fee.
13. If a trader is for any reason unable to attend the Market and occupy his stall, it is the responsibility of such trader to contact the Market Manager on 07460 441227. The intention of this requirement is to ensure that the appearance of the Charter Market is maintained, as empty spaces may indicate a lack of interest and detract from the vitality on the Charter Market.
14. Breaking these rules may result in terminating the trader's right to trade at this market.
15. The Market Manager reserves the right to decline a new application if the trading line is deemed unsuitable for the market or is deemed a conflict of interest for incumbent traders at the market.
16. The Market Manager reserves the right to amend these rules if required, after consultation with Market Management Team.



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
