Clive Sherwood Cup

Sport Award for 11-18 year olds



Nominations for the Clive Sherwood Cup are sought from sports clubs based in Cirencester. This is a new annual award recognizing individual contribution and achievement in sport. The award is open to anyone aged between 11 – 18 years old at the time of nomination, who have either progressed in a sport, shown leadership / coaching potential or contributed towards the club`s achievements in some way.

Clive Sherwood, who was a long serving member of staff at Cirencester Town Council, was due to retire from his position as Deputy CEO in October 2013, but sadly passed away following illness after years of dedicated commitment to the Council and local community in Cirencester where he worked, and Tetbury where he lived.

Colleagues at Cirencester Town Council felt it appropriate to recommend that Clive`s memory live on in a positive way. Clive loved sport, particularly football (being a Tottenham Hotspur supporter) and golf. In his younger days he coached a youth football team in Tetbury when his children were growing up. In consultation with Clive`s family the Town Council has established the Clive Sherwood Cup.
