Parking in Cirencester Town Centre for Blue Badge Holders

There are dedicated spaces with ease of access to the shops in the following offstreet car parks:

• **Abbey Grounds** • **Brewery** • **Forum** • **Old Station** • **Waterloo**

Blue Badge holders can also park in the designated pay and display bays in the Market Place and along Castle Street, free of charge for up to three hours.

Please note that Cricklade Street is a pedestrian zone and prohibits access to traffic, including Blue Badge holders, from Monday to Saturday between 9.30am and 4.30pm.
