#### II. Narcan© Training | Lee Waingortin, BSN, RN, CCM

- a. The purpose of this training is to increase awareness about opioid abuse, the effect of Narcan© on opioid overdoses, and how to recognize and respond to a suspected overdose.
- b. Lee will be providing this training as part of the Massachusetts Department of Public Health (MDPH) Naloxone pilot project.
  - i. Naloxone is an opioid antagonist that blocks the effect of opioids such as heroin, oxycodone, hydrocodone, fentanyl, codeine, and methadone.
  - ii. In response to the increasing number of opioid-related fatal overdoses in Massachusetts in the past decade, the MDPH is sponsoring a pilot program to distribute intra-nasal naloxone (Narcan©) and opioid overdose prevention education to opioid users and to trusted people in their lives.
