The birds and frogs have been chirping, the sun is inching its way higher into the sky, and Angie's anemones are starting to bloom.

We have been working to get ready for the spring and summer farming season. Our propagation house is quickly filling up with baby plants and the hoop houses are being prepped for onions and spring greens. This is also a great time of year for us to organize the farm and to finish projects that get left unattended during the summer rush.

The recent heavy rain and cold weather has made it difficult for many of our farming partners to keep their greens in good shape, particularly lettuce. This has also meant that they have had a hard time getting into their fields to plant for the spring. Fortunately, we are able to work with farms like Full Belly in the Capay valley, who are able to provide us with broccoli this week. That is no easy feat in February! Potatoes and our super sweet carrots continue to be a staple from us at Mountain Bounty during these hard growing months.
