

Design Goals & Guiding Principles

- The Connector is part of the ongoing implementation of the Mystic River Reservation Master Plan
- The Connector shall be direct and shall maximize opportunities for users to view and be close to the River
- The Connector shall be designed primarily as a community route while implementing the regional network goals
- The Connector shall be accessible and inviting to people of all ages and abilities, including students and seniors
- The Connector shall be designed to address the privacy and security concerns of abutters
- The Connector shall improve the habitat and ecology of the riverbank























Riverbank Restoration Planting Locations
