Cleveland ASHRAE Obituaries

We mourn the recent loss of long-time active members of ASHRAE:

James M. Pier, Sr. died August 2, 2007, following a long struggle with cancer. Jim founded J. M. Pier Associates, Inc., and dynamically led that organization for many years, while continuing his strong support of ASHRAE throughout. He can truly be said to have changed the marketing of mechanical equipment in Northeast Ohio. Survivors include wife Brenda, ASHRAE member Jim Pier Jr., five other children, and eleven grandchildren. Services were held at St. Sebastian Catholic Church in Akron.

William Reid died August 6, 2007 at age 78. Bill had continued to operate Reid Industrial Sales, and regularly attend ASHRAE meetings through last spring. He was always the courteous polished gentleman, and a friend to all. He had also served as a Commander in the U. S. Navy. He is survived by his wife of 47 years, Harriet, three children and nine grandchildren. Services were held at the Evangelical Covenant Church in Hudson.

Charles J. Cammock, Jr., well known to many older ASHRAE members for his sense of humor as a sales representative, died recently at age 91. Charlie would be pleased to be remembered as the father of "Value Engineering" - he was fond of telling of his first job in the construction industry. He worked for his carpenter father, making a substitute for rare and expensive "wormy chestnut" wood out of ordinary lumber, using a hand drill. His product then was then made into elaborate paneling for Euclid Avenue mansions.

Robert M. Hopper, a retired Member of ASHRAE, died recently at the age of 89. Bob was active in the Cleveland Chapter in the late 1970s, and was formerly with Suburban Power Piping, located in the building which was later converted into the Rain Forest at the Cleveland Metroparks Zoo.
