Cleveland Chapter Wins ASHRAE Government Activities Award

The Cleveland Chapter of the American Society of Heating, Refrigerating and Air-Conditioning Engineers (ASHRAE) has received the Society's Government Activities Award.

The award was presented at the Society's Annual Meeting held here June 25-29. The award recognizes as ASHRAE chapter for outstanding effort and achievement in state, provincial and local government activities in connection with technical issues related to the activities of the Society.

The chapter centered its government activities around ASHRAE's satellite broadcast on homeland security held in April 2003 due to the "potential avenues" of discussion this would open up with government personnel and other business groups.

The chapter invited local government and business officials to the program, which was held at no cost to the chapter at a local television station.

Those invited include representatives from the Federal Reserve Bank of Cleveland, the General Services Administration, the Cleveland branch of the Department of Homeland Security and the City of Cleveland's Office of Emergency Preparedness. The chapter reports good attendance at the event.

ASHRAE, founded in 1894, is an international organization of 55,000 persons. Its sole objective is to advance through research, standards writing, publishing and continuing education the arts and sciences of heating, ventilation, air conditioning and refrigeration to serve the evolving needs of the public.
