## Carlos Huber joins forces with Australian Art Quartet in concert

Fragrance designer, architect and historian Carlos Huber will join forces with the Australian Art Quartet for its final recital this year in a show called Scent of Memory.

Performed at Sydney's Yellow House next month, audiences will be led through a curated exhibition of fragrances made by Huber matched to a program of music from composers including Arvo Part, Gurdjieff, Mountfort and Tchaikovsky.

Huber first studied architecture in Paris, but when he moved to Spain he was intrigued by the strength of different aromatic environments coupled with architectural history. With a degree in historic preservation from Columbia University in New York, Huber now travels the world trying to recapture the olfactory notes of historical moments.

Previous Art Quartet concerts have included live painting, nudity and electric shocks, but these shows on November 9 and 10 will be its first attempt at combining scent and sound.
