Our hearts were broken. We started the process, desperate to make our baby better.

Dr. Fish, the head of the burn unit at SickKids, said that his mobility would be fine and emotionally he would be fine. But, there would be a scar. He then said, "you know what though, there's nothing you can't do with a scar."

Those words - Nothing You Can't Do - stuck with me.

I wrote this book for Chet. But, I also wrote it for children everywhere. I truly believe that all kids should grow up knowing that there's nothing they can't do, in this whole wide world, no matter what.
