The Logan City School District enters into this partnership purchasing agreement with

The partnership purchasing program is designed to give students access to technology, increase student ability to collaborate with others, and enable the creative pursuits connected with effective digital learning environments.

Description of the Partnership Device

The DISTRICT will partner with the student in the acquisition of the following device and accessories, according to the terms and conditions specified in this Agreement:

1. 2015 MacBook Air 11"
2. Power cord for the device.

Throughout this Agreement, use of the term "device" is understood to include all of the items listed in this section.

Terms of Agreement

This agreement begins on the date of purchase, _____

As long as the student remains enrolled in the Logan City School District, the DISTRICT agrees to:

1. Diagnose technical issues and suggest repair options. These include but are not limited to: re-imaging the computer, loaning a device during major repairs, and/or providing repair estimates for damaged devices and sending the device off for repair as needed.
2. Provide support and training to the student user when needed.
3. Transfer ownership of the device upon the completion of the student's enrollment with the DISTRICT. It is understood that once the student leaves the district:
 - They no longer have access to the DISTRICT IT department for support or repair.
 - They no longer have access to software that uses a DISTRICT license, including, but not limited to Microsoft Office and Adobe Applications.
 - Students will have access for a limited time after leaving the district to their student email, and any files stored on the DISTRICT server.

As long as the student remains enrolled in the Logan City School District, the STUDENT agrees to:

1. Keep the device free of irreversible personalization attempts, e.g., stickers, etchings, or any other permanent mark or fixture.
2. Use the device in a careful and responsible manner and contact, and contact IT immediately to report any problems with, or damage to, the device.

Terms of Agreement, continued

3. Pay repair costs, in keeping with the Electronic Device Accident Repair Plan form that was signed upon initial receipt of the device.
4. Assume responsibility for supervising the use of the device, following the guidelines of the District's Electronic Device Policy and Responsible Use Agreement. The student further agree to comply with and conform to all national, state, municipal and other laws, ordinances and regulations governing the possession, use or maintenance of an electronic device.
5. The student and parent/guardian shall indemnify and hold harmless the DISTRICT and its agents against any and all claims, actions, suits, proceedings, costs, expenses, damages and liabilities, including attorney's fees and costs arising out of, connected with or from the device, use of the device, or this Agreement, including, without limitation, the manufacture, delivery, possession, use, operation, or return of the device.

Conditions and Expectations

1. Full ownership of the device will transfer to the student/guardian after the last day of school for the purchase year.
2. The DISTRICT is not liable for the condition, ongoing use or any data or hardware issues related to a purchased device once ownership is transferred.
3. Ownership is transferred to the student only after device is paid for in full. If the device is not paid for in full, and the student does not return the device by the last day of class, any remaining balance will be sent to collections.
4. Accident Protection Policy payments are non-refundable and cannot be applied toward the purchase price of a device.
5. The purchase of the device is non-refundable. This signed form is binding and the money owed becomes the debt and responsibility of the student and parent/guardian
6. The DISTRICT calculates the depreciation rate for a device based on the purchasing price and what the district considers the zero-value year of the device (The zero-value year is the year the district determines a device may be in inventory before it costs more to maintain than it is worth having for another year.)

By signing this agreement, I acknowledge that I have read, and agree to, all the conditions of the Partnership Purchasing Agreement listed above. I acknowledge that the purchase of a device from the Partnership Purchasing Program is dependent upon the fulfillment of all terms expressed above and compliance with the Partnership Purchasing Policy established by the school district.
