Monomoy Capital Partners (“Monomoy”) is committed to respecting and protecting the privacy of its Website users. Please read this privacy policy carefully to understand what information Monomoy collects about users of this Website and how it uses and shares that information with others. This privacy policy applies only to this Website and to other websites that link to this privacy policy. This policy does not apply to information collected in any other way by Monomoy (whether offline or online), nor to any information obtained by third-party websites which may be linked to by this Website.

In addition to this privacy policy, if you are an investor in a Monomoy Fund, then our investor privacy notice that is required by the Gramm-Leach-Bliley Act of 1999 is also applicable to you.

Monomoy reserves the right to modify this privacy policy at any time by posting the revised version on this Website and updating the effective date. Such changes will be effective upon posting. We encourage you to check this Website frequently to see the current privacy policy in effect and any changes that have been made to it.

What Information Do We Collect?

Monomoy and third parties working on our behalf collect personal information that you provide on this Website or on third parties’ websites as designated by Monomoy that link to this privacy policy, such as through forms you choose to submit to contact us to obtain more information about or register for an event. Personal information may include, but is not limited to, names, addresses, phone numbers, e-mail addresses, and other data you may provide us so that we can contact you.

Monomoy, third parties working on our behalf, and our partners, including social networking sites, may also place, view, and/or use “cookies,” web server logs, web beacons, and other electronic tools to collect statistical information about your use of this Website and other websites.

How Do We Use and Share Your Personal Information and Other Information?

Monomoy and third parties working on our behalf use the information we have about you for internal business purposes, as well as to communicate with you, respond to your requests, enhance our services to you, compile aggregate statistics, and improve this Website. Monomoy and third parties working on our behalf may also use your

information to provide you with information about this Website and its services, and about Monomoy. To assist us with our use and sharing of your information, information covered by this privacy policy, including information about your use of this Website, may be combined with or enhanced by other information that we have from other online or offline sources.

We may also share your information with third parties as permitted or required by law, including: (a) with service providers that assist in operating our business; (b) to comply with the law or in response to a subpoena, court order, government request, or other legal process; (c) to produce relevant documents or information in connection with litigation, arbitration, mediation, adjudication, government or internal investigations, or other legal or administrative proceedings; (d) to protect the interests, rights, safety, or property of Monomoy or others; (e) to enforce any terms of service or other legal disclosures on or related to this Website; (f) in connection with a sale or other transfer of all or some of the assets of Monomoy and/or in connection with a sale or merger of Monomoy or any division of Monomoy; (g) to provide you with the services or products requested by you, and to perform other activities related to such services and products; (h) to operate Monomoy's systems properly; or (i) any other sharing with your consent.

Cookie Policy

As described above, Monomoy, third parties working on our behalf, and our partners, including social networking sites, may also place, view, and/or use cookies, web server logs, web beacons, and other electronic tools to collect statistical information about your use of this Website and other websites. Such information may include your device's IP address, browser type, operating system, computer platform, web pages viewed, the date and time of your visit, the links you click within this Website, the websites used prior to visiting this Website, and whether you have been to this Website before. before accepting cookies, disable cookies entirely, or how to disable the collection of geo-location data. You need to set each browser, on each device you use to surf the Web. Similarly, if you connect to the Web from multiple devices (e.g., work and home), you need to set each browser on each device. Security

Accessing and Updating Your Personal Information

Consent to Transfer of Personal Information to Other Countries

Some of the uses and disclosures mentioned in this privacy policy may involve the transfer of your personal information to various countries around the world that may have different levels of privacy protection than your country. By submitting your personal information through this Website, you consent to such transfers and to the processing of your personal information in such countries for the purposes described in this privacy policy.

Your Rights to Your Personal Data if you are an E.U. Resident

For the purposes of applicable European Union laws, Monomoy may act as a data controller of any personal data collected by us. In simple terms, this means that we: (i) “control” the personal information that you provide, including making sure that it is kept

secure; and (ii) make certain decisions on how to use and protect your personal information, but only to the extent that we have informed you about the use or are otherwise permitted by law.

If you are a resident of the European Union, under the General Data Protection Regulation (“GDPR”), you have the right to access the personal information we hold about you, and there are a number of ways you can control the way in which and what information we store and process about you. Access: You have the right to ask for a copy of the personal information that we hold about you free of charge, however we may charge a ‘reasonable fee’, if we think that your request is excessive, to help us cover the costs of locating the information you have requested.

Correction: You may notify us of changes to your personal information if it is inaccurate or it needs to be updated.

Deletion: If you think that we shouldn’t be holding or processing your personal information any more, you may request that we delete it. Please note that this may not always be possible due to legal obligations.

Restrictions on use: You may request that we stop processing your personal information (other than storing it), if: (i) you contest the accuracy of it (until the accuracy is verified); (ii) you believe the processing is against the law; (iii) you believe that we no longer need your data for the purposes for which it was collected, but you still need your data to establish or defend a legal claim; or (iv) you object to the processing, and we are verifying whether our legitimate grounds to process your personal information, override your own rights.

Object: You have the right to object to processing, including: (i) for direct marketing; (ii) for research or statistical purposes; or (iii) where processing is based on legitimate interests.

Portability: If you wish to transfer your personal information to another organisation (and certain conditions are satisfied), you may ask us to do so, and we will send it directly if we have the technical means.

Withdrawal of consent: If you previously gave us your consent (by a clear affirmative action) to allow us to process your personal information for a particular purpose, but you no longer wish to consent to us doing so, you can contact us to let us know that you withdraw that consent.

We may need to request specific information from you to help us confirm your identity and ensure your right to access your personal information (or to exercise any of your

other rights). This is a security measure to ensure that personal data is not disclosed to any person who has no right to receive it. We may also contact you to ask you for further information in relation to your request to speed up our response.

You also have the right to lodge a complaint if you believe that we have not complied with the requirements of the GDPR regarding your personal data. Should you wish to lodge a complaint with regards to how your personal information has been processed by us, please contact your local supervisory authority.
