

Instructions

Multiple Entry Tourist Visa (METV)

Updated: 2/03/2017

The METV allows multiple entries into Thailand for a maximum of **60 days per entry**. This visa is only valid for a 6-month time frame starting from the date the visa is issued.

You therefore must enter Thailand within a 6-month time frame.

1. The application form must be completed and submitted together with the following:
 - Original Passport which must be in order and valid for **AT LEAST 6 months**, beyond the proposed date of entry into Thailand.
 - 1 recent passport sized photograph on a white background (3.5x4.5cm).
 - Flight itinerary or e-ticket entering Thailand.
 - Application Form A (Completed and Signed).
 - Evidence of adequate finance showing no less than AUD \$8,000 **OR** 200,000 Baht (if Thai bank account) as follows:
 - Official Bank statement, linked to the applicant by name, with a closing balance, and issued within the last 6 months **AND/OR**
 - Official credit card statement issued within the last 6 months, illustrating the current balance and credit card limit.
 - Non-Australian citizens must provide proof of Australian Electronic Visa.

The fee is **AUD \$225**. (See point 2 for payment methods).

NOTE: The Consulate reserves the right to request more documents if required.

2. Fees to be paid in Australian Dollars and made out to '**Royal Thai Consulate General Melbourne**' by the following methods; **bank cheque, money order, or cash only**. Personal and company cheques **WILL NOT** be accepted.
3. All visas will take a minimum of 2 working days to process once a complete application has been received.
4. **Visas by Mail:** All applications sent via mail must include all of the requirements and payment made out to '*Royal Thai Consulate General Melbourne*'.

Important: Visa applications will only be accepted if they are sent via registered post and will only be returned if they include a self-addressed registered envelope, or express post with signature on delivery (examples pg.2).

▶ NON-IMMIGRANT (stay up to 90 days per entry) not for holiday

Retirement Spouse / Family visit

Working Holiday Volunteer / NGO

REMARK FOR TOURSIT VISA AND TRANSIT VISA

- 1. The validity of visa is 3 months for Tourist Single Entry, Transit Single & Double Entry and 6 months for Tourist Multiple Entry as shown on ENTER BEFORE date on the visa. You must enter Thailand before this date
- 2. Upon Arrival in Thailand, the actual length of stay (starting from the date of entry) shall be determined and granted at the discretion of Immigration Officers at checkpoint

CONDITIONS AND DECLARATIONS

- 1) Each application is considered upon individual merit and may be rejected without any reasons provided.
- 2) Visa processing fee is non-refundable under any circumstances. 3) Regulations are subject to change without notice. 4) Consular officers reserve the right to request additional documents as deemed necessary.
- 5) The Royal Thai Consulate Sydney assumes the right to deny or grant any type of visa to the applicant.
