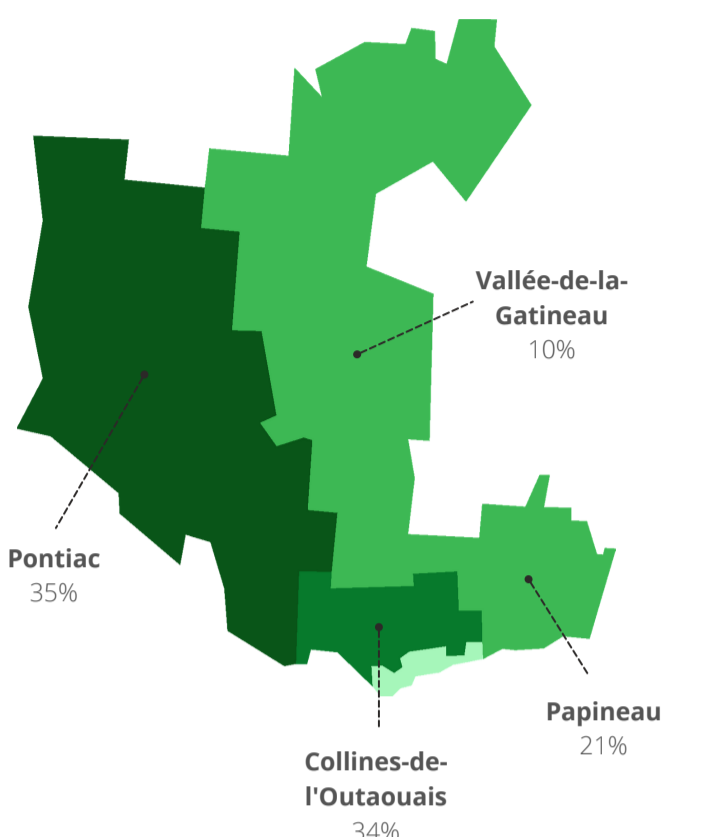


# Survey results: PRIORITY ISSUES FOR WETLANDS AND WATER BODIES IN THE OUTAOUAIS

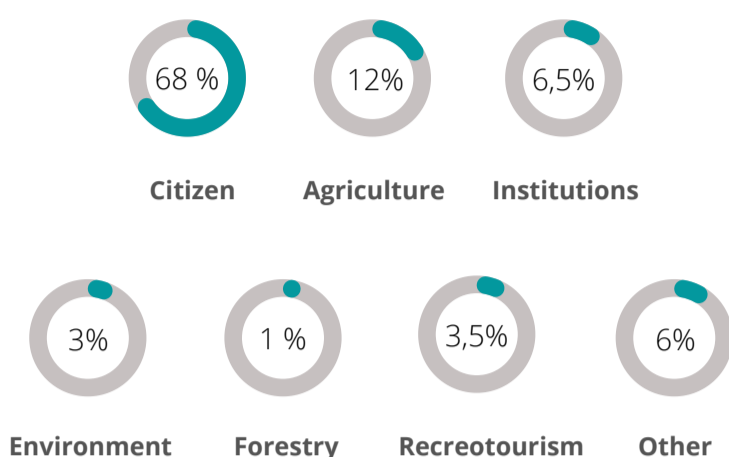

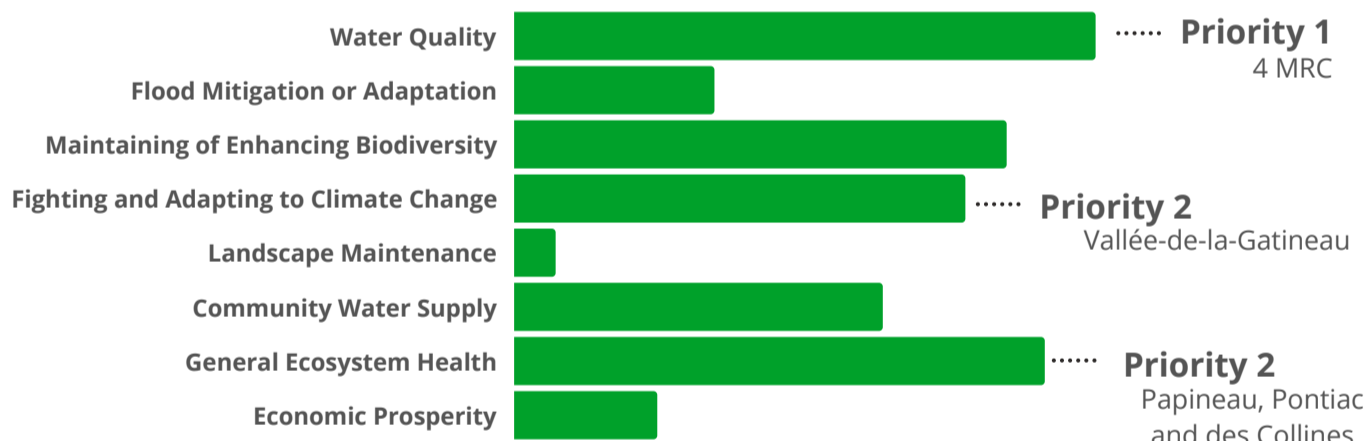

Hydrology

- > Water quality (color, temperature, sediments)
- > Water level
- > Bank erosion
- > Floods



Biodiversity

- > Decline in animal biodiversity
- > Devegetation
- > Invasive species



Anthropogenic

- > Pollution (physical and chemical waste, septic system)
- > Traffic
- > Construction
- > Restrictions
