## Spring Creek Forest Pool Rules

- 1. Lifeguards are responsible for the safety and conduct of swimmers in the pool area.
- 2. No one will be admitted to the pool area without being identified by the Lifeguard as a resident in good standing.
- 3. Residents who have quests must sign them in at the Lifeguard table and be responsible for them at all times. Approval to bring groups of 10 or more must be obtained from the SCF HOA Board 14 days prior to use of the pool.
- 4. All children 9 or younger must be accompanied by an adult 18 years or older.
- 5. There will be a 10 minute break every hour. Children under the age of 18 must leave the water during this time. Children under 6 may use the baby pool with adult supervision.
- 6. Appropriate swim attire (swim suit) is required for adults and children. No cutoffs. No street clothing worn in the water.
- 7. Any child who is not toilet trained must wear a swim diaper in the pool.
- 8. No running or rough play.
- 9. No loud, abusive or foul language, no loud music and no public intoxication or disorderly conduct.
- 10. No glass containers.
- 11. No diving from the side of the pool.
- 12. No pets.
- 13. No swimming after posted hours.
- 14. No smoking anywhere on the SCF properties with the exception of the parking lots.

Lifeguards are employed to insure the safety of swimmers. They have the authority to remove from the pool area anyone disobeying the rules or endangering the safety of themselves or another person. The lifeguards have the authority to suspend the offender for the day. Additional and repeat violations will be turned over to the SCF Homeowners Board. These violations could result in revocation of swimming privileges for the remainder of the summer.
