

Stars Open Tour is a tennis tournament for recreational players, held in Croatia. The Stars Open Tour 2021/22 will consist of eight tournaments throughout the year in different Croatian cities, kicking off with the event in Zagreb on December 9-12, on the Tennis Club Prince tennis courts.

Each Stars Open Tour tournament will feature around 200 competitors in 4 categories:

- single recreational
- doubles recreational
- Pro single for former pro players, and those wishing to play against them
- Pro doubles one player in a doubles team is a former Pro player









Throughout the tour, an official ranking list is maintained, using a precise scoring system. A ranking list will be published, with the results and the total number of points collected for each individual (Single) and each pair (Doubles). At the end of the season, the winners will be announced after all the points have been added.
