

## FRIENDSHIP MEDALLION – Part 1 (Log Cabins and 4-Patches)

### LOG CABIN BLOCKS:

#### From assorted red prints, cut:

(4) 1 ½" squares (#1 center)

#### From assorted light prints, cut:

(4) 1 ½ x 4 ½" rectangles (#7)

(4) 1 ½" x 3 ½" rectangles (#6)

(4) 1 ½" x 2 ½" rectangles (#3)

(4) 1 ½" squares (#2)

#### From assorted dark prints, cut:

(4) 1 ½" x 5 ½" rectangles (#9)

(4) 1 ½" x 4 ½" rectangles (#8)

(4) 1 ½" x 3 ½" rectangles (#5)

(4) 1 ½" x 2 ½" rectangles (#4)

Lay out the pieces as shown in the photo. The number after the size of the rectangles indicates the position where it is sewn. Begin sewing a light 1 ½" square to the 1 ½" center square (red print). Add the next 1 ½" by 2 ½" rectangle to the sewn squares. Continue adding rectangles as shown in the photo. Make (4) log cabin blocks measuring 5 ½". Sew the four log cabin blocks together as shown.



### FOUR PATCH BLOCKS:

From assorted light prints, cut: (8) 3" squares

From assorted dark prints, cut: (8) 3" squares

Pair a light and dark print 3" square; sew together. Press the seam allowances toward the dark print. Make a second pair. Join the pairs to make a four-patch block. Press the seam allowance in one direction. The four-patch unit should measure 5 ½" square, including the seam allowances. Repeat to make (4) four-patches. (See photo)
