The Lawyers with Disabilities Division is working with employers in the legal sector to offer work experience opportunities to students and law graduates who inspire to be solicitors.

A number of employers are taking part in the scheme including law firms in private practice and in-house departments from the public and private sectors. This includes Slaughter and May, Stephenson Harwood, local authorities and more.

The work experience scheme can offer you:

- Work experience for 1-2 weeks from May 2018- September 2018
- Part/full time positions available.
- Reasonable adjustments, if required. For example, flexible working time.
- Paid reasonable travelling expenses*

This scheme is available for applicants at any stage of their career in law, whether at student or post qualification level. Please don't be deterred if you feel you do not have the academic criteria for this scheme.

Please note the work experience scheme is unpaid. However some firms may be able to pay for your reasonable travelling expenses.
