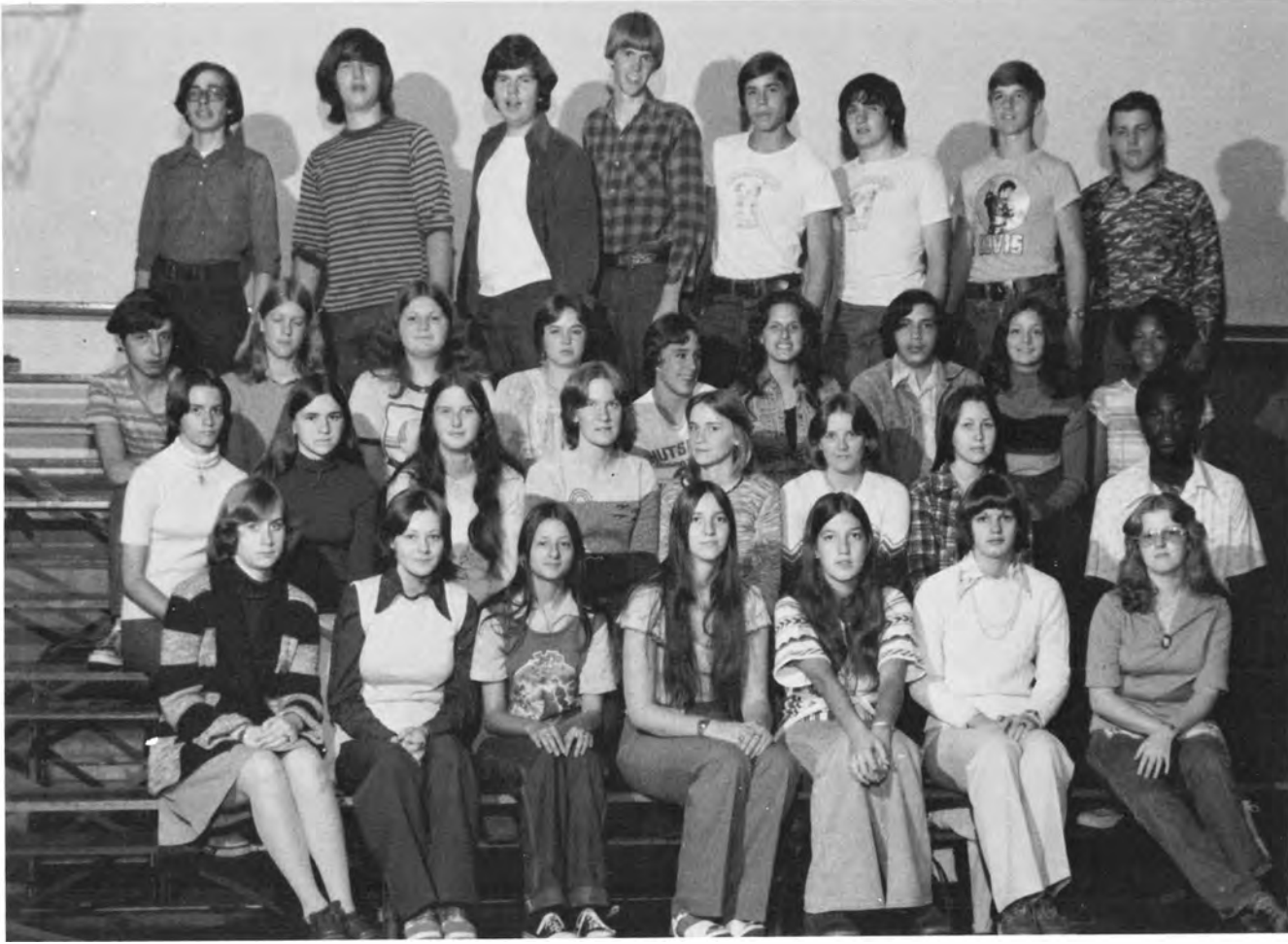
## Dedication
