Dear Parents,

I would like to take this opportunity to provide you with further information regarding the Year 6 residential visit to the Kingswood Centre at Dukeshouse Wood. The children will be accompanied by Mr Toner and Mrs Devlin with Mrs Iannotti and Mrs Bourne sharing parts of the week. The programme is packed full of challenging and fun activities which I am sure the children will enjoy.

Please find attached the kit list for guidance on packing.

Can I please reiterate that valuables or money MUST NOT be taken including cameras, mobile phones and other electrical items such as ipods etc. We will have a group camera and will provide photos for you after the trip.

The children will be leaving school on Monday 5th June at approx. 1.00pm and so should come to school as normal in the morning but dressed for the week (i.e. no uniform) and with their bags packed – one with items for the week that they will not be able access until they unpack in their rooms later in the day and a backpack with things for the day.

We will leave the centre after having eaten lunch on the Friday 9th June at 1.00pm with an anticipated arrival of 2.30pm. You will therefore need to arrange for them to be collected from school at that time. If you have other children at the school you may collect them at the same time or if you cannot make the earlier pick up time – please let us know in advance.

If your child needs any medication, including for travel sickness, please hand these with written instructions (form enclosed) directly to Mr Toner on the Monday morning. Please complete the slip below for authorisation to administer Calpol 6+ (if appropriate) to your child if they are feeling unwell during our stay – from experience, we have found this very useful.

If you have any further queries do not hesitate to contact me. I am sure that the children (and adults) will have a fabulous time and come back with great stories of their experiences and adventures.
