We would like to invite you into school to look through your child's work with them so that they can show you what they have been learning in school in all of the different subjects.

This will be an opportunity for you to look at their books and talk to them about their learning. We will be encouraging the children to take the lead on the session and therefore it is not a time to discuss work and books with the class teacher, but rather with your child, so *they* can show you what they can do and are proud of.

The sessions will run as follows...

Children with surnames beginning with A-L will be showing their books from 2.15-2.45

Children with surnames beginning with M-Z will be showing their books from 2.45-3.15.

If you have children in more than one class, please go to your oldest child's class first and make your way to your youngest child. Once you have looked at your child's/ children's books, you may (if you wish) sign them out and take them home when you are finished if this is before home time.

Refreshments will be available in the hall for a small donation towards school funds.

If you are not able to make the session, then do not worry- children without a grown-up present will be able to share their books with their teachers and friends throughout the afternoon.
