

Arizona Highways Photo Workshops: The Canadian Rockies

Welcome to the Pacific Ring of Fire.

The craggy summits of the Canadian Rockies soar high above fertile valleys. Sparkling lakes capture stunning reflections of glacial peaks and dramatic summer clouds. Known as “God’s Country,” there is no better season to experience its unparalleled splendor than in summer. Join landscape photographer Jim Steinberg on an epic week-long adventure, capturing the pristine beauty of Banff and Jasper National Parks. With Jim’s expert guidance, you will learn to hone the craft of landscape photography in one of the most beautiful regions in the world.



Your trip begins in the foothills of Calgary, heading west into the mountains of Banff, Canada’s oldest national park, where ancient glaciers, waterfalls and alpine landscapes await your lens. Dominating the views of the Bow Valley is Mt. Kidd, reflected in the waters below. From there, you head northwest along the Trans-Canadian Highway, capturing iconic views of the Wenkchemna Peaks and Lake Louise.

Then, countless stops along the Icefields Parkway and the glacial lakes of Jasper, where a wide variety of wildlife is easily sighted. On the way back through these untouched forests, you will have opportunities to capture the raging Class 5 waterfall at Athabasca and the gentler flow of Tangle Falls before heading back into Calgary.

With Jim Steinberg’s wealth of knowledge and regular constructive critiques, you will learn to create striking images that capture the essence of the region’s placid waters and soaring peaks. This workshop combines beautiful surroundings, comfortable lodging and picture perfect scenery. Come experience the majestic Canadian Rockies and take home your own personal vision of North America’s most treasured territories.
