

JOHNNIE LEMAY OUTSTANDING STUDENT AWARD

You are applying for the Johnnie LeMay Outstanding Student Award.

This is not the application for the Johnnie LeMay Scholarship.

Eligibility Requirements:

- ❑ Student must be in the second year of education in a program who is accredited by an agency approved by the American Registry of Radiologic Technologists.
- ❑ Student must be a WSRT member in good standing.

APPLICATION PROCESS:

- ❑ To apply for The Johnnie LeMay Outstanding Student Award applicant must submit:
 1. The Johnnie LeMay Outstanding Student Application Form
 2. The Johnnie LeMay Outstanding Student Documentation of Educational Sessions
 3. Program director statement of verification
 4. Copy of transcript
 5. Copy of WSRT membership card
- ❑ Submit application (which includes items 1 - 5 above) to the Executive Secretary.
- ❑ Postmark deadline for application is **April 1st**.

SELECTION CRITERIA: Points will be tallied and the student with the most points will receive The Johnnie LeMay Outstanding Student Award. Points are awarded as follows:

- ❑ Length of Membership with WSRT—1-4 months: 1 pt.; 5-9 months: 2 pts.; 10-13 months: 3 pts.; 14-17 months: 4 pts.; 18-24 month: 5pts.
- ❑ Academic Achievement - 30 points possible—Grade point average for Radiologic Technology courses only:
