Light bodied and refreshing acidity. Almond and green fruit. Try with polenta fries.	
Firriato, Etna Bianco, Sicily 2015	70
Crisp acidity with minerality and saline character. White peach and apricot notes.	
Ronco dei Tassi, Collio Bianco ‘Fosarin’, Friuli 2015	71
Blend of Friulano, Malvasia and Pinot Bianco. Medium bodied with creamy texture of barrel ageing. Stonefruit notes. Ideal match with prosciutto.	
Roccolo Grassi, “La Broia”, Soave 2012	84
Medium bodied with bright acidity. Apricot, peach and savoury herbs. Some textural weight with partial barrel ageing.	
Erste + Neue, Pinot Grigio, Alto Adige, 2015	70
A crisp, refreshing Pinot Grigio from the region in the alps where it is more highly regarded. Beautiful purity with clean, citrus lime fruits. A fresh, focused mineral driven wine.	
Tiberio Pecorino, Marche 2015	91
Fleshy weight and elegant stone fruit and saline minerality.	
NORTHERN ITALIAN REDS	
Ascheri, Dolcetto D’Alba, 2014	65
Lighter bodied red wine, with fruity character. Perfumed with red berry character.	
Vietti, “Tre Vigne”, Barbera D’Alba, 2014	87
An iconic producer in Piedmonte. Bright acidity, soft tannins, cherry and berry flavours.	
Produttori, Barbaresco, 2012	112
Made from the Nebbiolo grape, think of this wine as like Pinot Noir but with more structure (alcohol and tannin). A traditional Barbaresco with floral and berry notes.	
Azelia, “Bricco Fiasco”, Barolo, 2012	162
The Bricco Fiasco is considered a great wine from a great region. This is undisputedly a very fine wine with a powerful structure, pronounced acidity and tannins with grip. Nutty, with earthy, mushroomy notes yet approachable despite its young age.

Medium Bodied red wine from La Marche. Juicy red and dark fruits.

Blend of Sangiovese with a little Merlot. Medium bodied with cherry and plum fruits.	
Felsina, Chianti Classico, 2013	96
100% Saniovese. Medium bodied with chalky tannins. Red cherry and grilled herbs and an earth nature character.	
Isole E Olena, Chianti Classico, 2012	106
Sangiovese with a little Canaiolo and Syrah. Medium bodied with a smoother and velvety structure, Dried balek cherry and wild cherry. A very elegant example of Chianti Classico.	
Antinori, "Peppoli" Chianti Classico, 2014	75
Aromas of cherries, violets, spice and vanilla. The palate is savoury, balanced with crisp acidity with moderate tannins. From one of Chianti's most iconic producers.	
Buon Tempo, Brunello di Montalcino Alta, 2010	122
Full bodied with a dark brooding character. 50% new oak gives warming spice and cedar notes. Deep concentrated flavours of dried dark berries and cassis.	
Poggio Antico, Brunello di Montalcino, 2010	162
Medium bodied wine with plum, berry and spice notes. The high altitude of the vineyard means the wine has fine tannins. This is a very elegant example of Brunello di Monalcino.	
SOUTHERN ITALIAN REDS	
Alta Mora, Etna Rosso, Sicily, 2013	91
Light bodied, with focused acidity. Fresh fruit integrated with spices, pepper and mountain herb. Tannins are firm, yet fine. An elegant wine that resembles Pinot Noir in many ways.	
Cos, Frappato, Sicily, 2014	96
Fresh, light bodied red wine. Low in tannin and with bright acidity. This style of wine is very fruit driven and perfumed. A great example of the best natural winemaking.

In late 2005 The Bicycle Thief opened in what was once a covered carpark housing a dozen or so cars off Latimer Square in Christchurch city.

Named after the 1948 film “Ladri di Bicielette” (which translates literally as “Bicycle Thieves”) the film is set in poverty stricken post WWII Rome and tells the story of a man struggling to support his young family.

After 18 months queuing for work he is finally offered a job as a billsticker poster, which is dependent upon having a bicycle. On his first day of work the bicycle is tragically stolen, sending him on a desperate search through the streets of Rome.

The Bicycle Thief at Latimer Square survived the 2011 Canterbury earthquakes with minor damage but the politics and doctrine of the CBD rebuild saw the site “required”.

In early 2016 The Bicycle Thief re-established, leaving the city for the bucolic Canterbury countryside between Halswell and Tai Tapu.

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
