## TERMS & CONDITIONS

### PLEASE READ AND SIGN OWNER'S DECLARATION

1. Cork Canine Rehabilitation Centre is committed to providing a highly professional, caring and friendly service to all their clients and animal patients.
2. All dogs must have a veterinary referral form signed by their Veterinary Surgeon stating that they are in a suitable state of health to undergo aqua and hydrotherapy treatment. This form should be faxed to 021 4321444 or emailed to [corkcaninerehabcentre@gmail.com](mailto:corkcaninerehabcentre@gmail.com) prior to the first appointment.
3. Whilst every care is taken with all dogs receiving aqua and hydrotherapy treatment and in the maintenance of the water and equipment, all dogs enter the pool at the owner's own risk.
4. All dogs must be up to date with their annual vaccinations and a card must be produced on request. Flea and worm treatment must also be kept up to date, and in accordance to the animal's veterinary surgeon's instructions (e.g. monthly flea treatment, worm treatment every 3 months)
5. Dogs should receive veterinary health checks on a regular basis to ensure they are continually fit to receive aqua and hydrotherapy.
6. Owners are required to notify Cork Canine Rehabilitation Centre if, during a course of treatments the injury, or condition worsens, if medication changes, or if the veterinary surgeon advises that the treatment is stopped or suspended.
7. Cork Canine Rehabilitation Centre reserves the right to refuse treatment to any dog.
8. Dogs with infectious or contagious conditions such as ear, eye or skin infections, or vomiting or diarrhoea will not be treated, due to the health and safety reasons. Please inform us if your dog is in season, as she will not be allowed entry into the pool/underwater treadmill, until her season has finished.
9. Please ensure your dog is relatively clean prior to the hydrotherapy session. Cork canine Rehabilitation centre maintain the right to refuse to allow a dog with a particularly dirty coat entry into the water, in this incidence, a full fee will be charged.
10. Do not feed your dog for at least 2 hours prior to session.
11. All sessions, including insured dogs must be paid for on the day of treatment, preferable by cash or cheque. (Non-Refundable)
12. Cork Canine Rehabilitation Centre reserves the right to charge for any appointment which is broken without prior notice. A cancellation fee of 50% of the appointment fee will be charged to the client when appointments are cancelled with less than 24 hours notice.
13. Cork Canine Rehabilitation Centre reserves the right to reschedule/cancel any appointment.
14. All dogs within and outside Cork Canine Rehabilitation Centre must be kept on a lead and under control at all times.
15. All dogs must be given a chance to toilet prior to appointment. It is the owner's responsibility to ensure that the dog has had enough time to do this BEFORE their appointment. Please ensure you give yourself enough time to do this BEFORE your scheduled appointment. If the pool is fouled, then there will be an additional charge of €65.00 to allow for closing the pool and extra cleaning.
16. Owners are responsible for cleaning up after their dogs whilst on the premises and in the surrounding area. Bags are available on request.
17. For your information a Veterinary Surgeon is on call during the Centre opening hours.
18. Cork Canine Rehabilitation Centre will maintain the highest water quality at all times.
19. Your animal will be towelled dry. Please bring your own towels and coat to keep your dog warm after the session. Please ensure you bring towels for your car also.
20. Please ensure you wear suitable clothing and shoes (non-slip), as you will be entering a wet environment.
21. Our centre is not the ideal environment for young children. Should it be necessary for clients to bring children, in the interest of health and safety they must remain with the accompanying adult at all times whilst on the premises.
