It is kind of wild actually, so. I'm excited about that. I love it. I saved it for you.

I love the spontaneity of this show.

I really do, really do. I got this one and I hope whoever's listening Whoever sent this in because it's anonymous.

They sent it through my website That's how I didn't see it at first because it went in my spam folder And so I was looking for something else and I was like, oh wait What's this one here?

[8:01] Wow, what else is happening in your life since the last time nothing man.

I just had a lot of positive stuff going on Um, I got a better human.

I am. I've always been a good human. It's just your listeners. Don't think so.

Um, I really be doing real shit behind the scenes, but, um, you really do.

I will give you credit for that. Cause you just, people don't know that you gave Thanksgiving meal.

[9:48] Three weeks ago, I got my real estate license. So I was already a loan officer and then I decided to be more on the sales side because it gave me a chance to be independent. Sitting behind a desk, crunching the numbers, it was cool. It made me, I feel like, put me in a better position to be a realtor.

So it's like when you get to talking to people and they feel like, oh, this realtor didn't know this or that, they just kept telling me, call a loan officer, call a loan officer.

Like, yeah, some stuff you do got to call a money person because they're the ones who handling your deal, but I should be able to ask a basic question if you're like, well, what's going to be the difference in this house?

Every \$10,000 is going to be \$60 to \$70 more on your payment.

Just something simple like that, or understanding, well, if I'm at this interest rate and the seller gave me this much, can I buy my rate down?

Simple questions. This is the most responsible our listeners probably ever heard you be.

Yeah, so they need to call me. I bid you to fucking Nino Brown at Thanksgiving and shit. Yeah, out there passing out turkeys.

Anybody want to buy, sell, rent, or hold? Just holler at me.

We'll do all of that. But I got accepted to Morgan's MBA program.

Shout out to- Look at all of this.

Yeah, so I got accepted to the MBA program and going back to school.

I said I was never going back. I said I was never, ever in my life going back.

And then I was like, I'm only going back if it's free.

So Monday I got the, yesterday was Monday, right? So yesterday I found out, yeah, I got a full scholarship.

So I'm going back and I'm just, I'm always busy, still got the business, still working a full-time job.

[11:38] Taking care of my 50 million kids. But I always feel like it's not enough.

And sometimes people don't realize how people get there.

And it's like, you got to really go- What happened to you to get you there?

Real talk? I got laid off in 2019. I'm like, it's always a story.

No, yeah. And it is, because you were there.

And it's stuff that we don't discuss and people don't know, but when you get to that point where you be like, yo, I got this education, I got this skill set, I got that skill set, and it's just so easy for somebody to take.

80% of the money that you make away in one swoop.

It's a scary feeling when you got unemployment, you're going through your savings.

I had to postpone me buying a house. That's why it was such a big deal when I talked about buying a house because I ended up taking that savings.

You start dipping in your 401k. We got grown people bills now.

Grown people bills. Ain't no whore. Ain't no joke.

The challenges of unemployment and homeownership

[12:34] So it ain't like you get to unemployment and you're like, yeah, this shit gonna hold me. You're like, this shit like. Ain't puttin' up for us.

Yeah, it's like, what unemployment give you is the shit your wife will give you.

Like covering the BGE, cable, shit like that. Like, you start getting shit cut off.

Unemployed will keep you fed with heat. Yeah. And maybe some gas in your car, if you got no car note.

[12:56] And you ain't paying the fucking mortgage. That's why I say like, that's what the wife gonna give you.

Like, she gonna pay the BG&E, she gonna pay the wifi, she gonna pay the cable, shit like that. And then you gonna be like, okay, like, Oh, you only putting \$1,000 a month in here? Oh, all right, I'll see. That's how you know we owe. Because I was telling somebody that the other day, they were saying there's really no advantage to owning versus renting now because of the cost. And I was like, that's not necessarily true.

I said, because when Tom's get, if Tom's ever got hard, hard, and I couldn't pay this mortgage at the first of the month, they not putting that notice on my door. It's going to take years for me to be homeless, baby.

Oh, yeah, and you could call them and be like, yo, I need you to, like, I'm in this situation.

Can you put me in forbearance? Can you put my payments to the back?

Can we even if your credit takes a hit they can't immediately tell you get the fuck out your house, right?

So it may be a temporary setback, but I know I'm gonna have a fucking roof over my head I'm not gonna be out here on the streets and to me that is as big of a advantage Then just take an equity out of your house. I mean you can basically be like look I got, 100,000 equity in my house. I know I'm about to lose this job.

I got laid off before something happened. Let me figure out a way where I could go ahead and get some money out to help pay these bills or pay this debt off and then set myself up. It's a lot of different things you can do, but it's definitely an advantage because tax season is big because all you're paying- That's the only thing that saved me.

Yeah. All you're paying in the first 10 to 15 years of your amateurization is nothing but fucking-Interest.

Yeah. Yeah, you're paying all the interest. You're not paying on a principal.

[14:24] So yeah, we're getting a little deep. Man, listen, we on some real I'm an adult grown problem shit.

[14:31] Well, we say responsible and ratchet, so we got our responsible part out.

All right, responsible, check. Let's go.

So ratchet, OK. I said I had a listener letter.

[14:41] I wish that, let me pull this up on my phone so that I can read and see your face.

You giving it to them already? You want to give it to them this fast?

Do you want to? Cause I feel like this- No, no, go ahead and give it to them.

Go ahead and give it to them. I feel like this- Sometimes we make them wait.

Sometimes we do, but I feel like this one could spiral. And so I'm sending it to myself so I can read on the phone so I can look at your face at the same time. I'm scared. I'm scared. So I got this listener letter guys.

But then the person followed up with a second one. And I said, oh, shit, this was real, because they said, did you overlook my letter?

And so I was leaving my spam folder, looking for something else, and found this letter. So it says, hey, guys, my partner, girlfriend, fiancee.

We're both in our 20s as well, around 25. And we're from the UK.

Hey, we got international listeners, motherfucker.

That's why it's almost like just something you've seen on a baby, and you see a little fucking quarter taped to him.

Maybe he should put a fucking quarter over it. I don't know.

Is it too late? Would a quarter still work? It's not gonna work.

I would just, at the end of the day, I would just be like, Look, fucking stop.

At some point, you got to just be honest with your partner and just be like, stop.

If they're doing some shit that they like and you don't like, at some point, you got to just be like, yo, I don't like that shit.

That's the only real advice because there's nothing you can do to mess with her belly button that's going to be like, oh yeah, now I know how he feels.

I don't know how you pronounce, an alvenophilia. That's probably where Aldi came from.

Where individuals are attracted to a human navel. In 2012, it was the second most popular fetish search on Google.

[20:17] So, I think it's sexy when you kiss down a woman's stomach and you kiss around her navel and down the little ... If they got even the little line that used to be there, like a little hairline almost, but a little black line. The happy trail, yeah.

Yeah, so it's like taking you down and you're trying to be sensual, so you ... You're trying to take your time, but you really want to rest right down there and start giving a hiss.

Well, here's the thing- Are you trying to play like you sensual?

That's it. But I ain't never been like, let me lick inside that motherfucker.

Like some people don't clean in there.

How is he doing that? You feel that?

Yeah, nigga, you hurting my ribs. Are you playing?

[23:14] He think he finger popping you, and he got his fucking finger in your belly.

But you have a point. You know my pussy is not on my belly.

Right, yeah. Way too high. You know, some men probably don't.

Like, the babies are in your belly, so maybe they think that.

I don't even think you need sex education to figure that out. Come on.

You think so? No. I also, I know somebody and this wasn't on know.

[23:39] I know somebody who dated, this is you, this is not anybody I know personally, this was like in my 20s, but this girl was dating this guy and she's like, they were having sex, quote unquote.

And she says, she's like, you know, you know, put it in. And he's like, it is.

And she's like thinking, oh my god his dick is so small but she realized the second time they went to go have sex that he was never putting the dick in her pussy he was just like putting it in between the meat of her thighs and he was fucking her thighs this is the stuff that men don't believe that are there this is why men can't that's why i feel like you have that's why i feel like you have to grab the dick You do, you have to take control.

Look at you. Everybody has their place in the ecosystem. Yeah, because it's like sometimes you might just be like in the mood when you have a squirter on deck.

You might just be in a mood for that nasty shit where that shit just be squirting everywhere.

But the hard part about that is- You got to clean that shit up.

You got to clean that shit up.

Like everybody was just fucking her. Like, and I'm sorry if that's your story and now you don't want to listen to me anymore and Brian's a dickhead, but if that's your story, no, because I know so many women that we went to school with and it was like, yo, she ought to change, she this, she that.

And she was like, oh, she a hoe or she a freak. Everybody fucked her.

And now you look up and be like, oh, she with a woman.

That's what KG told me. Kenny was like, he's posting every day about Diddy.

The last person I want to beef with is 50.

He is the pettiest person out there.

Like, when it got to the point where like, when him and Ja Rule was done, and Ja Rule was like over, and he wouldn't let it go, I was coming like, come on, yo.

It's like you watching somebody beat somebody up, and they just stomped them, and everybody pulled them off of them.

Like, come on, yeah. like, getting they self together and you just come back over like, pow, still on, like, come on, yo. That was a nice answer.

No, he definitely is a habitual line stepper. Like, yo, he, I'm terrible.

I feel like I'm terrible.

[48:45] Um, but yeah, and the sad thing to say for some people, JLo has a credibility that they won't let Cassie, right?

So if there was something that happened with her and Diddy, people would believe her over believing Cassie because that was the whole argument too.

Cassie was a gold digger. And I'm like, no, no, no, no, back this train up.

She went to him and he offered her money and she could have got an eight figure check and none of this could have, would have went public and she could have got Check in so I'm like eight figures is between 10 million and 99 million dollars She could have been paid and set but she filed them charges and that has settled within 24 hours So immediately off that that lets me know he did Even if he didn't do 100% of what she claimed he at least did 80% and.

[49:30] That's that wasn't more than enough so yeah, and that's that's crazy because

The Sad Reality of Power and Control in Abusive Relationships

[49:34] it's like it really makes me sad because Having daughters and seeing women be in positions of men with power or money Like, at a certain point you are liable because you stayed, now, you know, was the lifestyle that good that you...

Partaking in all of this stuff. I think I was watching Fall of the House of Usher on Netflix and it just like- I haven't watched it, but I know what you're talking about. Yeah.

So it's this whole thing where the more you see these different shows and movies, and it's almost like an exaggeration sometimes, but it's real.

People with money are so bored with what they have that they're so extreme with their sex lives and the things that they Anything.

Yeah. Yeah. And so it's like when you've had as many women as he had, and it becomes a whole thing about control and controlling this young girl is crazy, but it's believable because I know people without money that do it.

So if niggas get away with it with nothing and they're not paying no rent and not doing nothing and still controlling chicks with just dick, you know that somebody with millions and millions and access and talking about she wanted to talk to you.

The grip is a lot different with that kind of power and money.

Yeah, because she wanted to be an artist as well, and every time she talked to a different manager, he beat her ass.

Like the whole thing came out where he beat her ass in the hotel, took her in another room and beat her ass because she was talking to another manager, you know.

So, also to me, it made more sense, because I remember I was like, why would she get with the trainer?

I'm like, the trainer probably saw things and saved that ass one day.

And that's what happened.

Right, and she probably felt safe that, okay, like, he'll fuck his ass up, or he thorough enough. Like, women, I always feel like this whole thing, right?

When y'all date the next guy after a certain guy, y'all want to at least feel like he gonna stand up to this dude. You know what I mean?

Can he at least make my baby daddy feel like he can't come over here and act crazy? Like, that's the whole thing.

Yeah, that should be sexist shit. I feel like a lot of women at the end of the day have said things like I feel safe physically or like... I mean, safety is a big thing.

Let me just clear this up. I've said it before, I'll say it again.

The protection part is not just physically, right?

But I still feel like a lot of women think because, okay, he went to college and he not I know thug nigga like how I'm supposed to feel safe.

Like at the end of the day, like I'm not trying to get into a situation where I got to pull my gun or shoot somebody, but I'm also a little bit off to the point where like there's certain things that I'm gonna intervene.

[54:43] Like it's times when I had been out and I had to learn that being married and in relationships, it wasn't my job to always swat a nigga away who was trying to talk to my woman.

I married her because I felt like she was beautiful. I have a people feel like that. Well, I knew she had a fat ass and I knew she had that dress on.

So I have to now pull myself back as an older, more mature man and realize I could die just because a nigga said you had a fat ass or touched you.

So now my job is like, look, Boonie, you got fucking 45 seconds to one minute, 45 seconds to get this nigga out your face before the fuck I come over.

This is your backyard Nigga, just walking down the street chill, but the dog is naturally gonna be like don't come close to this yard You know what? I mean?

I'm nodding cuz I understand I get it. But now that I'm older I don't feel like that.

I don't want to have to fight your baby daddy I don't want to have to get to the point where I go to jail for the rest of my life It's got to be a great reason for me to have to throw hands with something over something That's mine because these days the risk it may not just be hand like yeah, nobody wants to fight He was one part of gun.

[58:05] Turning a gun and having had you know, like a gun license like it's a different story and I told my friends like Yo, you be flipping like you got a gun You don't carry or you carry sometimes when you're going over these chick houses.

You gotta put your shit right on that Right on a nice thing, Well, all of a sudden you hit it, Hey, I know somebody in here, bitch, open the door. You got to now ask yourself, like, well, what's it going to be?

Am I going to stay here all night? Or am I going to walk out this door?

But you don't know, because these chicks be lying, talking about, oh, no, I don't mess with him no more. And he just was over there two, three weeks.

You don't know, because your over is different from her over.

Everybody got these little toxic situations, like I've been.

Yes No, you weren't because you dropped your Shoe on the way out from the murder and you bought one new shoe from shoe city the next day.

This day and age, you ain't committing too many crimes and not getting caught.
