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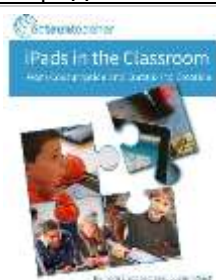

- Setup iPad with either parent iCloud account but as new iPad or by creating a new iCloud.com account
- Only parent knows App store password
- A new Google account that only parent knows password to can set web filter in all Google services.
- The Google account does not have to be used by the child but will allow for web filtering and also monitoring of any account use. Example: setting up other web services like Mosh Monsters.com

9 Starter Tips for Teachers Who Just Got iPads

iCloud **Apps** **Vision** **SAMR** **Guide** **Work** **Pswd** **Help!** **Smile!**

- 1** For iCloud account setup, take the 'Create new iCloud email' option to gain full functionality. Don't use your existing email. E.g. iCloud can only sync Notes using an iCloud email.
- 2** Don't rush to look for subject specific apps. Focus on generic tasks. E.g. Writing, Filming, Drawing, Discussion. One screen of Apps should be all a learner needs. [MORE](#)
- 3** Don't expect the iPad to be a laptop but focus on the new opportunities. iPad learning is Mobility, Filming, Tactile creativity. Realise that even then a continuous journey is often the most successful. [MORE](#)
- 4** Google "The SAMR Model" to learn that harnessing the true power of iPad learning is at least a 2-year process and even then a continuous journey thereafter. [MORE](#)
- 5** Expectations and correct practice is best discussed with the class. Lots of creative activity, photos & films need to be moved to cloud storage as much as possible. When to charge the device, what to do when tasks are finished & device etiquette all need to be clear. [MORE](#)
- 6** Written, drawn, photographed or filmed, it's important to have one system look after it all and a slow collaboration. Here are 3 favourite ones: [Google Drive](#), [Evernote](#), [Dropbox](#). [MORE](#)
- 7** Every student (& Teacher) should have ONE password for everything used at school. This should be a strong password with 8 characters, a capital & a number. E.g. **Dance1ng**. You can then have one password for home and a unique one for banking. [MORE](#)
- 8** Even if your school or district won't fund much PD, there are tons of free webinars and iPad blogs out there. Most importantly, get on Twitter and build your Personal Learning Network. Without a PLN, it will be hard to keep up and that 99% of the time, the iPad can do it. [MORE](#) & [MORE](#)
- 9** It will be slow and messy at first but discovering new ways as a class is an important part of the process. Failing and Let kids know that failure is okay, and not everything will be perfect. Have fun trying something new and remember that 99% of the time, the iPad can do it. [MORE](#)

Trudacot is a classroom walkthrough template and/or a unit (re)design template that will allow educators to assess technology integration within the context of higher-order thinking skills steeped in important disciplinary concepts. Here's the short version:



- A. Personalization / Individualization / Differentiation**
- B. Agency / Control / Ownership / Choice / Interest / Passion**
- C. Communication**
- D. Collaboration (co-working, co-creating; more than just communication)**
- E. Authenticity / Relevancy**
- G. Critical Thinking (HOTS + metacognition) / Creativity / Initiative / Entrepreneurship**
- H. Technology**
- I. Assessment**

TPACK Explained

At the heart of the TPACK framework, is the complex interplay of three primary forms of knowledge:

1. Content (CK),
2. Pedagogy (PK), and
3. Technology (TK).

Technological Pedagogical Content Knowledge (TPACK) attempts to identify the nature of knowledge required by teachers for technology integration in their teaching, while addressing the complex, multifaceted and situated nature of teacher knowledge. The TPACK framework extends Shulman's idea of Pedagogical Content Knowledge.

The Seven Components of TPACK

The TPACK approach goes beyond seeing these three knowledge bases in isolation. The TPACK framework goes further by emphasizing the kinds of knowledge that lie at the intersections between three primary forms: Pedagogical Content Knowledge (PCK), Technological Content Knowledge (TCK), Technological Pedagogical Knowledge (TPK), and Technological Pedagogical Content Knowledge (TPACK).
