



## Summer Intern Positions

The Infant Toddler Children's Center, a private, not-for-profit childcare program, is located on 3 acres in a residential setting in Acton, MA. Our outdoor spaces include 4 age-appropriate play yards, a nature trail through the woods, and a small children's garden. Our indoor spaces are equally well-appointed and offer rich possibilities for exploration and adventure.

ITC is an innovative year round full day program for children 3 months to 8 years old, where children are encouraged to develop their innate capacities in their own unique style. Teachers build curriculum based on individual children's interests and skill development through careful observation, thoughtful reflection and collaborative planning.



We are looking for 2-3 summer interns to work with our teachers from early June through August 11<sup>th</sup>. Interns have an opportunity to work alongside seasoned educators and experience a high-quality school environment that supports children, families and teachers.

Candidates must be teacher-qualified through Massachusetts EEC, have current First Aid and CPR training, a curiosity about young children, and an eagerness to grow professionally. Interns are paid \$15/hour and can expect 30-38 hours/week.
